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A CONFIRMING RESOLUTION designating an "Economic Revitalization Area" under I.C. 6-1.1-12.1 for property commonly known as 2704 Goshen Road, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46808 (RMD Resources, LLC)

WHEREAS, Common Council has previously designated and declared by Declaratory Resolution the following described property as an "Economic Revitalization Area" under Sections 153.13-153.24 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, and I.C. 6-1.1-12.1, to wit:

Attached hereto as "Exhibit A" as if a part herein; and

WHEREAS, said project will create five full-time, permanent jobs for a total additional annual payroll of \$156,000, with the average new annual job salary being \$31,200 and retain one full-time, permanent jobs for a current annual payroll of \$31,200, with the average current annual job salary being \$31,200; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated project cost is \$674,000; and

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been received from the Committee on Finance concerning said Resolution: and

WHEREAS, notice of the adoption and substance of said Resolution has been published in accordance with I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-2.5 and I.C. 5-3-1and a public hearing has been conducted on said Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That, the Resolution previously designating the above described property as an "Economic Revitalization Area" is confirmed in all respects.

SECTION 2. That, the hereinabove described property is hereby declared an "Economic Revitalization Area" pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-12.1, said designation to begin on the effective date of this Resolution and shall terminate on December 31, 2011, unless otherwise automatically extended in five vear increments per I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-9.

SECTION 3. That, said designation of the hereinabove described property as an "Economic Revitalization Area" shall apply to a deduction of the assessed value of real estate and personal property for new manufacturing equipment.

SECTION 4. That, the estimate of the number of individuals that will be employed or whose employment will be retained and the estimate of the annual salaries of those individuals and the estimate of redevelopment or rehabilitation and estimate of the value of the new manufacturing equipment, all contained in Petitioner's Statement of Benefits are reasonable and are benefits that can be reasonably expected to result from the proposed described installation of the new manufacturing equipment.

The current year approximate tax rates for taxing units within the City would be: SECTION 5.

- ... If the proposed development does not occur, the approximate current year tax rates for this site would be \$3.0384/\$100.
- ... If the proposed development does occur and no deduction is granted, the approximate current year tax rate for the site would be \$3,0384/\$100 (the change would be negligible).
- ... If the proposed development occurs, and a deduction percentage of fifty percent (50%) is assumed, the approximate current year tax rate for the site would be \$3.0384/\$100 (the change would be negligible).
- ... If the proposed new manufacturing equipment is not installed, the approximate current year tax rates for this site would be \$3.0384/\$100.
- ... If the proposed new manufacturing equipment is installed and no deduction is granted, the approximate current year tax rate for the site would be \$3,0384/\$100 (the change would be negligible).
- If the proposed new manufacturing equipment is installed and a deduction percentage of eighty percent (80%) is assumed, the approximate current year tax rate for the site would be \$3.0384/\$100 (the change would be negligible).

SYNOPSIS OF ORDINANCE: This is to confirm the designation of an Economic Revitalization Area for RMD Resources, LLC for both real and personal property improvements in the amount of \$674,000. RMD Resources, LLC will make interior and exterior renovations to two buildings as well as purchase new manufacturing equipment.

EFFECT OF PASSAGE: RMD Resources, LLC will expand into new facilities that will enable them to remain competitive locally. Five full-time jobs will be created as a result of the project.

EFFECT OF NON-PASSAGE: Potential loss of development and five full-time jobs
