SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE GARBAGE AND RECYCLE CART MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT to the Garbage and Recycle Cart Maintenance Agreement ("Second Amendment") is entered as of January 1, 2012 (the "Effective Date") by and between The City of Fort Wayne Indiana by and through its Board of Public Works ("The City") and Toter, Incorporated ("Toter").

RECITALS:

The City and Toter previously entered into a Garbage and Recycle Cart Maintenance Agreement (the "Maintenance Agreement") the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, which will expire December 31, 2011 and a first amendment thereto which extended the term of the Maintenance Agreement. The City and Toter now desire to extend the Maintenance Agreement for an additional two (2) years and to amend the Maintenance Agreement in certain respects, all as hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE, good and valuable consideration the acceptance of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The Maintenance Agreement will be extended for a period of two (2) years beginning January 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2013.
- 2. Exhibit B of the Maintenance Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

All carts are to be serviced within 72 hours of notification. Toter Incorporated will be responsible for all parts and labor associated with repairing the carts both warranty and non-warranty issues. Serial numbers and all other service related information as asked for by the City are to be recorded and provided to the City on a monthly basis. The City has purchased two handheld RFID tag readers that are to be used when servicing the carts. Any garbage carts taken off the street shall be retrofitted with an RFID tag before they are put back into service. The cost for this service shall be \$2 per tag. This includes cost of the tag, parts, and labor to insert the tag into the cart.

Toter Incorporated shall replace at no cost to the City all stolen carts or missing carts (move-ins) up to a threshold of 1,200 carts per year. The City agrees to purchase all remaining carts used to replace those stolen or missing above this threshold annually.

Both the Garbage and Recycling Cart Maintenance Agreements will have the same charges for In-Service, Exchanges and Pick-ups. These charges are below:

In-Service - \$0.15 per cart per month Exchanges - \$15 per cart Pick-ups - \$15 per cart

There will be NO additional Assembly and Delivery charges.

In the event the City conducts a targeted inventory of garbage carts in certain areas, Toter Incorporated will pick-up, wash, and place back into inventory all unauthorized carts as instructed by the City. The cost for this service shall be \$11 per cart.

3. The City will purchase carts that are provided to newly built homes, where a resident has requested an additional cart, or for carts that our collection contractor has lost in the truck. Carts will be purchased at the following prices:

96 gal Garbage -\$51.33 48 gal Garbage - \$41.85 96 gal Recycle - \$53.97 48 gal Recycle - \$44.50

All prices include granite, freight, and Assembly and Delivery. Garbage carts include UHF RFID Tags. Recycle carts include Yellow Lids, IML and UHF RFID Tags. Prices will be held for one (1) year, with a price adjustment, up or down, based on the percent change in resin costs from the average price for January 2012 to the average price for January 2013. Changes will be determined using the Plastics News publication, Thermoplastics Commodity LLDPE, Butene-1, Comonomer Extrusion Liner Film.

- 4. This Second Amendment shall not be binding or obligatory upon the City unless and until it shall have first been approved by the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, and should the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne fail to approve the same within forty-five (45) days after the date hereof, this Second Amendment shall become void and of no effect and the rights and obligations of the parties hereunder shall thereupon extinguish.
- 5. Except as herein expressly modified, the Maintenance Agreement shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with its original term.

Re: Approval of Cart Maintenance Agreement Extension

The Solid Waste Department is seeking approval for the extension of the Garbage and Recycle Cart Maintenance Agreement. We are currently nearing the end of the first 2 year extension to the Agreement which was granted in December of 2009.

Pricing for the maintenance of the carts has remained the same which is \$1.80 per cart In-Service. This comes out to roughly \$260,000 per year. This is for the maintenance of over 87,000 garbage carts and 54,000 Recycle carts.

Service has been exceptional over the course of the agreement. The agreement states all work orders must be completed within 3 days of notification. Toter has over the course of the agreement completed work orders on average in less than 2 days. Currently they are at 1.1 days for garbage carts and 1.4 days for recycle carts.

We have had few issues with the Toter Carts. They have been very durable requiring few repairs or replacements. Toter repairs or replaces all damaged carts whether they are warranty or non-warranty claims. The combined warranty and non-warranty failure rate is 1.2 % which is extremely low considering the abuse that some of these containers take. If you look at just the warranty related damage, it would be less than 1%.
