12 **CONTROL PLANT, respectfully for:**

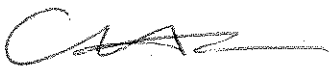

Phosphorous reduction is required by IDEM (Indiana Department of Environmental Management) during the waste treatment process. The plant feeds this chemical the entire year to meet the requirements of the NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) permit. A bid was completed with 2 bidders resulting in an increase of 12% per gallon.
