8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON
9 COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

10 SECTION 1. That § 156.04 of Chapter 156, Title 15 of the City of Fort
11 Wayne, Indiana Code of Ordinances be **amended** as follows:

12 § 156.04 Compliance with Zoning Code Required

13 No pool shall be constructed or installed unless it complies with all
14 applicable requirements as set forth in Chapter 157, Zoning Code.

15 SECTION 2. That §156.05 of Chapter 156, Title 15 of the City of Fort
16 Wayne, Indiana Code of ordinances be **amended** as follows:

17 § 156.05 RESERVED

18 SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from
19 and after its passage, and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor and
20 due legal publication thereafter.

RE: Swimming Pool Fencing Ordinance Amendment

This ordinance amendment clarifies the City's fencing requirement for swimming pools and brings those requirements into compliance with State Statute. Currently, both this Chapter and the Zoning Ordinance contain requirements for swimming pool fencing. The Zoning Ordinance has been brought into compliance with State Statute. Chapter 156 still contains out of date requirements.

This Ordinance Amendment removes the fencing requirements from Chapter 156 and references the more up to date requirements found in the Zoning Ordinance.
