

Purchase of Two (2) Power Transformers rated at 10/12.5/14 MVA, 34.5 kV x 69 kV

4160/2400 Volt for Stormwater Substation Resolution 2283-2010-P9, W.O. #75449

The seller will design, manufacturer, deliver, install assemble and perform commission testing of two (2) 10/12.5/14 MVA, 34.5×69 kV - 4160/2400 volt Power Transformers for the Stormwater Substation. These power transformers will serve the existing, additional and future electric loads at the Combined Sewer Pump Station, including the Effluent Pump Station and Northern Area Relief Pump Station (NARPS) as well as meet Indiana Michigan Power's future 69 kV transmission upgrades. This project is in support of our 2013 Consent Decree requirements and meeting our milestones.

<u>Implications of not being approved:</u> The existing substation power transformers do not have enough capacity to meet the additional electric equipment being installed as a part of this improvement to the Combined Sewer Pump Station (CSPS). Therefore, CSPS can't meet 2013 Consent Decree milestones.

This project was advertised to manufacturing vendors on April 13, 2012 and April 20, 2012 in the Journal Gazette and the News Sentinel.

The contract for Resolution 2283-2010-P9, awarded to Virginia Transformer Corp. for \$894,122.00 was the lowest most responsive bidder of the 2 bidders and 5.15% below the Engineer's estimate of \$942,642.00. The second lowest bidder was \$205,878.00 above Virginia Transformer Corp.'s bid.
