AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL APPROVING AND RATIFYING THE EXTENDING OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGANING AGREEMENT INCLUDING ALL MEMORANDA AGREEMENTS AND LETTERS OF AGREEMENT THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2013; AND FIXING, ESTABLISHING AND RATIFYING COMPENSATION FOR THE YEAR 2013 FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA REPRESENTED BY THE FORT WAYNE PROFESSIONAL FIRE FIGHTERS UNION LOCAL #124, INC.

WHEREAS, Common Council previously passed Special Ordinance No.S-85-09 approving the three (3) year (2010 – 2012) collective bargaining agreement for employees of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, represented by the Fort Wayne Professional Fire Fighters Union Local #124, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Fort Wayne Professional Fire Fighters Union Local #124, Inc., have agreed to a one (1) year extension of the 2010-2012 Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indianalaw, the compensation provided for therein must be annually ratified; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is necessary to ratify, fix and establish such compensation increased by two percent (2%) for the year 2013 for said employees of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana represented by the Fort Wayne Professional Fire Fighters Union Local #124, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The one (1) year extension of the 2010-2012 Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the Fort Wayne Professional Fire Fighters Union Local #124, Inc. and the City of Fort Wayne, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk and available for public inspection, is hereby approved and ratified in all respects.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.
