WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana determined, in accordance with the Foreign-Trade Zones Act and regulations relating thereto, that it was desirable to restructure Foreign-Trade Zone No. 182 under the Alternative Site Framework ("ASF") as announced by the Board in 74 Federal Register 1170 on January 12, 2009. And as such applied and received approval by the Board on June 24, 2011 to reorganize Foreign-Trade Zone No. 182 under the ASF; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana deems it desirable to make an Application for Expansion of the ASF Service Area of Foreign-Trade Zone No. 182, to the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:
