The bank of the north delta pond at Lakeside Park has been eroding precipitously due to wind and wave action. This results in a loss of Park terra firma and a deposition of pond silt. The bank erosion is both an environmental and a safety concern.

The proposed project will stabilize the bank with a combination of planted coconut fiber coir logs, rock outcroppings, and plantings at the water's edge. The rock outcroppings will provide immediate, safe access to the water's edge for fishing and passive recreation. The plantings will stabilize the bank, provide habitat for birds, improve water quality (fish habitat), and discourage nuisance Canadian Geese.
