An Ordinance approving ITB #3664 – City of Fort Wayne Wayfinding Sign System and the budget and the selection of a contractor (Burkhart Sign Systems) for the Fort Wayne Wayfinding and Signage project to be funded with Fort Wayne Legacy funds.

WHEREAS, over the last year Community Development and City staff have been formulating improvements and a design concept for the City of Fort Wayne Wayfinding and signage project with a planning budget of \$200,000,00 to be funded by Fort Wayne Legacy Funds; and

WHEREAS, on August 30, 2013, the Community Development staff initiated a public bid process through City Purchasing for the fabrication and installation of fifty-four (54) new wayfinding signs to be placed throughout the City, following the diagram made a part hereof and marked "Exhibit A"; and

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2013, eight (8) bids were received and were reviewed by Community Development and Purchasing staff for adherence to the criteria in the plans and specifications. Two (2) of eight (8) responses were determined to be non-responsive to the specifications and the collective recommendation by staff is that their bids be rejected as per the bid tabulation and review sheet enclosed as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, Burkhart Sign Systems with a bid of \$168,900.00 is judged by staff to be the lowest, best and most responsive bidder and is recommended for City Council approval accordingly.





MEMORANDUM

RE: City of Fort Wayne Wayfinding Program

Date: September 12, 2013

The Community Development Division has been working for the past year on a city-wide wayfinding sign system to complement the existing downtown wayfinding sign system. The purpose of this resolution is to approve a budget and the selection of a contractor for the funding of this system using City of Fort Wayne legacy funds in the amount of \$200,000.00.

The design for the Wayfinding program was coordinated and developed by a team that included Community Development staff, Traffic Engineering staff, and a consultant team comprised of The LandPlan Group and Design Collaborative. Public input was received in the form of 27 interviews conducted with community representatives in the areas of economic development, visitor attractions, and regulators or providers of visitor information. The proposed wayfinding sign system implementation (54 new signs) will include taking down many redundant and uncoordinated destination signs in favor of the new comprehensively designed system.

This proposed wayfinding sign system is also supported through a recommendation in the "Front Door Fort Wayne" plan and also through a recommendation by one of the Legacy Fund Champion Teams to the Mayor. The Mayor acting on this recommendation has proposed this project implementation and funding through the Legacy Funds.

The bid process for the wayfinding system began on August 30, 2013. Six contractors registered that they picked up or downloaded bid packets from the city's Purchasing Department. On September 16, 2013, 8 responses were received and were reviewed by Purchasing and Redevelopment staff for adherence to specifications and other criteria as contained in the plans. Burkhart Sign Systems, with a bid of \$168,900.00, is recommended by staff as the lowest, best and most responsive bidder. Bids from two firms were rejected due to their being incomplete and non-responsive to the specifications. We are seeking approval of a project budget of \$200,000.00 due to having knowledge that there will be adjustments to the project including the potential for the addition of signs as we work through final details for approval by INDOT of the wayfinding signs proposed along INDOT rights-of-way.
