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SECTION 1. The City of Fort Wayne Common Council hereby authorizes the Board of Trustees of the City of Fort Wayne Community Legacy Fund to distribute funds to the following projects:

Higher Education Scholarship Fund

Funds in the amount of \$200,000 will be provided from the City of Fort Wayne Community Legacy Fund on an annual basis for the City of Fort Wayne to contract with the Questa Foundation to deliver the Legacy Scholarship Fund. This fund will provide scholarships to help students attain degrees and training that are partially and potentially forgivable if the students stay in the area. An initial four-year award will be provided to fund the program in years 2014 through 2017. Commencing in November 2014 and annually thereafter, an annual report will be presented to and reviewed by Common Council, and Common Council shall vote to either end the program following the current four-year term or extend the program for an additional year. If Council votes to end the program, such action shall be final and not subject to the consent and/or approval of the Mayor. If Council votes to add an additional year, such approval shall be subject to the consent and approval of the Mayor.

Educational Services Fund

Funds in the amount of \$100,000 will be provided from the City of Fort Wayne Community Legacy Fund on an annual basis for the City of Fort Wayne to operate the Legacy Education Services Fund. The Legacy Education Services Fund will be used to fund educational programs to advance the educational attainment of the community by providing non-degree certification programs in collaboration with local partners. An initial one year award will be provided to fund the program in 2014. Commencing in November 2014 and annually thereafter, an annual report will be presented to and reviewed by Common Council, and Common Council shall vote to either end the program or extend the program for an additional year.
