**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS FROM  
THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE COMMUNITY LEGACY FUND**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Wayne has created the City of Fort Wayne Community Legacy Fund to invest in projects that will have a collective impact that leads to transformational change within the community, and;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Fort Wayne and the Fort Wayne Common Council seek to advance transformational projects for our community with a focus on economic development, downtown and riverfront development, and youth development/prep sports, and;

**WHEREAS**, each Legacy project provides our community with an opportunity to make our City stronger and better positioned for growth, and;

**WHEREAS**, working together we can leave a lasting Legacy for future generations,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City of Fort Wayne Common Council hereby authorizes the Board of Trustees of the City of Fort Wayne Community Legacy Fund to distribute funds to the following project:

**TIER 1 ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STUDY - \$200,000.00**

Legacy Funds will pay for a portion of the study that will lead to provisions for Fort Wayne passenger rail service to Chicago, IL and Columbus, OH. Study is to begin in 2014.

Adhering to the Guiding Principles established for the distribution of Legacy Funds, this project adequately meets the standards of providing transformational investment and leveraging additional resources that will provide long-term community impacts as the outcome of the project.
