Ordinance (Chapter 155) to be incorporated into the Updated and

Aligned Zoning Ordinance (ZORD-2013-0001)

Location: Within the planning jurisdiction of Fort Wayne

Applicant: City of Fort Wayne Plan Commission

Related Petitions: COMP-2013-0002 and ZORD-2013-0001. This ordinance is being

reviewed in conjunction with a similar amendment to the Allen County

Zoning Ordinance.

Effect of Passage: Several of the Land Use objectives and strategies of the Plan-It Allen

Comprehensive Plan touch on the need for both the Fort Wayne and Allen County zoning ordinances to be updated, as does the overall Land Use goal. The Governing Board has directed that the two ordinances also be aligned as closely as possible. The Legislative Streamlining project also has updating and aligning the two ordinances as primary objectives. This proposed amendment is intended to carry out the Comprehensive Plan objectives and strategies, carry out the direction of the Governing Board, and also complete the Legislative Streamlining project. If approved, this amendment will replace the current Fort Wayne zoning ordinance with an updated ordinance.

Effect of Non-Passage: The City of Fort Wayne will delay action intended to implement several

objectives and strategies established for land use by the Comprehensive Plan, will delay the implementation of the Governing Board's direction, and will

delay the completion of the Legislative Streamlining project.
