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# AGREEMENT BETWEEN OWNER AND CONTRACTOR ON THE BASIS OF A STIPULATED PRICE

Resolution 75877 Work Order 75877

THIS AGREEMENT is by and between the <u>Board of Public Works of the City of Fort Wayne</u>, <u>Indiana</u> (hereinafter called Owner) and **Atlas Excavating**, **Inc.** (hereinafter called Contractor).

Owner and Contractor, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, agree as follows:

#### ARTICLE 1 – WORK

1.01 Contractor shall complete all Work as specified or indicated in the Contract Documents. The Work is generally described as follows:

This proposed storm sewer system will consist of the construction of storm sewer extensions along Broadway, Ewing St., Fairfield Ave., Fulton St., Harrison St., Jefferson Blvd., Washington Blvd. and Webster St. This will consist of approximately 5,983 linear feet of 42", 36", 30", 24", 18", 15" & 12" storm sewer pipe. The storm sewer extensions will pick up existing street and parking lot inlets and catch basins that are currently connected to the combined system. It will also consist of 693 linear feet of 8" water main replacement along Fairfield Avenue, 60 linear feet of water main lowering for the associated storm sewer installation and 255 linear feet of sanitary sewer on Jefferson Boulevard and Webster Street.

#### ARTICLE 2 – THE PROJECT

2.01 The Project for which the Work under the Contract Documents may be the whole or only a part is generally described as follows:

#### Ewing St. East-West Storm Sewer Extension Phase II

#### ARTICLE 3 - ENGINEER

3.01 The Project has been designed by **DLZ Indiana**, **LLC**, which is to act as Owner's representative, assume all duties and responsibilities, and have the rights and authority assigned to Engineer in the Contract Documents in connection with the completion of the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents. Owner will confirm to Contractor prior to issuance of Notice to Proceed as to who will serve as Engineer.

#### **ARTICLE 4 – CONTRACT TIMES**

#### 4.01 Time of the Essence

- A. All time limits for Milestones, if any, Substantial Completion, and completion and readiness for final payment as stated in the Contract Documents are of the essence of the Contract.
- 4.02 Days to Achieve Substantial Completion and Final Payment
  - A. The Contractor shall complete the following activities of Work by the Milestone dates indicated. These Milestones are days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run as provided in Paragraph 2.03 of the General Conditions. Only one Project Area shall be constructed at a time.

Milestone 1: Install storm sewer, water main and complete all work called out to be installed on Ewing Street (Sheet 19), Fairfield Avenue (Sheet 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 38 & 39), Washington Boulevard (12, 13, 14 & 15) and on Jefferson Boulevard from Ewing Street to Broadway (Sheet 24, 25, 26, 28 & 29). Work shall be tested and approved, storm sewers shall be fully operational, concrete sidewalk and curb shall be fully restored, and asphalt/concrete street shall be completed including final surface. The work shall be completed 150 days after the Notice-to-Proceed.

Milestone 2: Install storm sewer from Str. C604 to C603 (including storm pipe and Str. C603-1 & C603-2) at the intersection of Jefferson and Webster and properly abandon the 54" combination sewer underneath Jefferson Boulevard (Sheet 30 & 32). Work shall be tested and approved, concrete sidewalk and curb along Jefferson shall be fully restored, and the asphalt street along Jefferson shall be completed including final surface. The work shall be completed **180 days** after the Notice-to-Proceed.

- B. The Work will be substantially completed within 270 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run as provided in Paragraph 2.03 of the General Conditions, and completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Paragraph 14.07 of the General Conditions by May 31, 2015.
- C. Definitions of Substantial Completion for this Work shall consist of the point in time when all Work, except final restoration of street, sidewalk, curb restoration and grass seeding has been installed and tested.

## 4.03 Liquidated Damages

A. Contractor and Owner recognize that time is of the essence as stated in Paragraph 4.01 above and that Owner will suffer financial loss if the Work is not completed within the times specified in Paragraph 4.02 above, plus any extensions thereof allowed in accordance with Article 12 of the General Conditions. The parties also recognize the delays, expense, and difficulties involved in proving in a legal or arbitration preceding the actual loss suffered by Owner if the Work is not completed on time. Accordingly, instead of requiring any such proof, Owner and Contractor agree that as liquidated damages for delay (but not as a penalty), Contractor shall pay Owner

\$2,500.00 for each day that expires after the time specified in Paragraph 4.02 above for Milestone 1, Milestone 2, and Substantial Completion until the Work is substantially complete. After Substantial Completion, if Contractor shall neglect, refuse, or fail to complete the remaining Work within the Contract Time or any proper extension thereof granted by Owner, Contractor shall pay Owner \$1,500.00 for each day that expires after the time specified in Paragraph 4.02 above for completion and readiness for final payment until the Work is completed and ready for final payment.

#### ARTICLE 5 – CONTRACT PRICE

- 5.01 Owner shall pay Contractor for completion of the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents an amount in current funds equal to the sum of the amounts determined pursuant to Paragraphs 5.01.A, 5.01.B, and 5.01.C below:
  - A. Not Used
  - B. For all Unit Price Work, an amount equal to the sum of the established unit price for each separately identified item of Unit Price Work times the actual quantity of that item:

See Article 5 (itemized Bid Schedule) of the Bid Form (00 41 00-3 – 00 41 00-7)

One Million, Six Hundred Ninety-Nine Thousand, Two Hundred Forty-Six Dollars and Zero Cents.

#### (\$1,699,246.00)

The Bid prices for Unit Price Work set forth as of the Effective Date of the Agreement are based on estimated quantities. As provided in Paragraph 11.03 of the General Conditions, estimated quantities are not guaranteed, and determinations of actual quantities and classifications are to be made by Engineer as provided in Paragraph 9.07 of the General Conditions.

C. Not Used.

#### ARTICLE 6 – PAYMENT PROCEDURES

- 6.01 Submittal and Processing of Payments
  - A. Contractor shall submit Applications for Payment in accordance with Article 14 of the General Conditions. Applications for Payment will be processed by Engineer as provided in the General Conditions.
- 6.02 Progress Payments; Retainage
  - A. Owner shall make progress payments on account of the Contract Price on the basis of Contractor's Applications for Payment within 30 days of receipt during performance of the Work as provided in Paragraph 6.02.A.1 below. All such payments will be measured by the

schedule of values established as provided in Paragraph 2.07.A of the General Conditions (and in the case of Unit Price Work based on the number of units completed) or, in the event there is no schedule of values, as provided in the General Requirements.

- Prior to Substantial Completion, progress payments will be made in an amount equal to the
  percentage indicated below but, in each case, less the aggregate of payments previously
  made and less such amounts as Engineer may determine or Owner may withhold, including
  but not limited to liquidated damages, in accordance with Paragraph 14.02 of the General
  Conditions.
  - a. 95% of Work completed (with the balance being retainage). and
  - b. <u>95%</u> of cost of materials and equipment not incorporated in the Work (with the balance being retainage).
- B. Upon Substantial Completion, Owner shall pay an amount sufficient to increase total payments to Contractor to 100 % of the Work completed, less such amounts as Engineer shall determine in accordance with Paragraph 14.02.B.5 of the General Conditions and less 200 % of Engineer's estimate of the value of Work to be completed or corrected as shown on the tentative list of items to be completed or corrected attached to the certificate of Substantial Completion.
- C. If the contract is in excess of \$200,000, the contract will be subject to the standard Board of Public Works escrow agreement unless written notice is received from Contractor prior to execution of the Agreement stating that an Escrow Account is not desired. If an Escrow Account is not desired, then the Board of Public Works, in accordance with IC 36-1-12-14, shall hold the retainage and will not pay interest on the amounts of retainage that it holds

### 6.03 Final Payment

A. Upon final completion and acceptance of the Work in accordance with Paragraph 14.07 of the General Conditions, Owner shall pay the remainder of the Contract Price as recommended by Engineer as provided in said Paragraph 14.07.

#### ARTICLE 7 - INTEREST

7.01 All moneys not paid when due as provided in Article 14 of the General Conditions shall bear interest at the maximum rate allowed by law at the place of the Project.

#### ARTICLE 8 – CONTRACTOR'S REPRESENTATIONS

- 8.01 In order to induce Owner to enter into this Agreement, Contractor makes the following representations:
  - A. Contractor has examined and carefully studied the Contract Documents and the other related data identified in the Bidding Documents.

- B. Contractor has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C. Contractor is familiar with and is satisfied as to all federal, state, and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- D. Contractor has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or contiguous to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site (except Underground Facilities), if any, that have been identified in Paragraph SC-4.02 of the Supplementary Conditions as containing reliable "technical data," and (2) reports and drawings of Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at the Site that have been identified in Paragraph SC-4.06 of the Supplementary Conditions as containing reliable "technical data."
- E. Contractor has considered the information known to Contractor; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Contract Documents; and the Site-related reports and drawings identified in the Contract Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Contractor, including any specific means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction expressly required by the Contract Documents; and (3) Contractor's safety precautions and programs.
- F. Based on the information and observations referred to in Paragraph 8.01.E above, Contractor does not consider that further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the performance of the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Times, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract Documents.
- G. Contractor is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Contract Documents.
- H. Contractor has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Contractor has discovered in the Contract Documents, and the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Contractor.
- I. The Contract Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance and furnishing of the Work.
- J. In connection with the performance of Work under this Contract, Contractor agrees to comply with Anti-Discrimination Under Indiana Code Chapter 5-16-6-1 and be bound by Chapter 93.036, of the Code of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana of 1974, passed by the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana as General Ordinance No. G-34-78 (as amended) on December 12<sup>th</sup>, 1978. Contractor shall file a Manpower Utilization Report for this project with the Compliance Office within ten (10) days after completion of the construction or upon request of the Office of Compliance.

- B. The documents listed in Paragraph 9.01.A are attached to this Agreement (except as expressly noted otherwise above).
- C. There are no Contract Documents other than those listed above in this Article 9.

D. The Contract Documents may only be amended, modified, or supplemented as provided in Paragraph 3.04 of the General Conditions.

#### ARTICLE 10 - MISCELLANEOUS

#### 10.01 Terms

A. Terms used in this Agreement will have the meanings stated in the General Conditions and the Supplementary Conditions.

#### 10.02 Assignment of Contract

A. No assignment by a party hereto of any rights under or interests in the Contract will be binding on another party hereto without the written consent of the party sought to be bound; and, specifically but without limitation, moneys that may become due and moneys that are due may not be assigned without such consent (except to the extent that the effect of this restriction may be limited by law), and unless specifically stated to the contrary in any written consent to an assignment, no assignment will release or discharge the assignor from any duty or responsibility under the Contract Documents.

#### 10.03 Successors and Assigns

A. Owner and Contractor each binds itself, its partners, successors, assigns, and legal representatives to the other party hereto, its partners, successors, assigns, and legal representatives in respect to all covenants, agreements, and obligations contained in the Contract Documents.

#### 10.04 Severability

A. Any provision or part of the Contract Documents held to be void or unenforceable under any Law or Regulation shall be deemed stricken, and all remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and binding upon Owner and Contractor, who agree that the Contract Documents shall be reformed to replace such stricken provision or part thereof with a valid and enforceable provision that comes as close as possible to expressing the intention of the stricken provision.

#### 10.05 Contractor's Certifications

- A. Contractor certifies that it has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for or in executing the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 10.05:
  - 1. "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process or in the Contract execution;
  - 2. "fraudulent practice" means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process or the execution of the Contract to the detriment of Owner, (b) to

- establish Bid or Contract prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
- 3. "collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish Bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and
- 4. "coercive practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.

#### 10.06 Emerging Business Enterprise(EBE) Participation

**EBE Retainage Requirements** – If the Contractor is in compliance with the provisions of the construction Contract the Owner will make payments for such work performed and completed. Pursuant to Executive Order 90-01 (amended 5-8-06); the Owner will retain five percent (5%) of the Contract Price to ensure compliance with the EBE participation requirements. Upon final inspection and acceptance of the Work, and determination by the Fort Wayne Board of Public Works that the Contractor has made a good faith effort to subcontract ten percent (10%) of the Contract Price to emerging business enterprises, the Contractor will be paid in full.

In the event there is a determination that good faith compliance with these EBE participation requirements has not occurred, appropriate reduction in the final payment pursuant to paragraph 10.06.E will be made.

If the Contract Price is in excess of \$200,000, the contract will be subject to the standard Board of Public Works escrow agreement. However, payments to the Contractor are not to exceed 95% of the total Contract Price until the Owner has verified that the Contractor has made good faith efforts to attain the 10% EBE goal stipulated in here within. Payment of the final 5% of the total Contract Price will be dependent upon acceptance of the Work, in accordance with Paragraph 14.07 of the General Conditions, and good faith efforts to comply with these EBE participation requirements; subject to reduction in the event of non-compliance as provided in paragraph 10.06.E.

- A. Request for Waiver If, at the time final payment application is made, Contractor has not attained the ten percent (10%) EBE goal, Contractor shall file with the final payment application a "Request for Waiver." Said Request for Waiver shall contain a written description of the efforts taken by Contractor to attain the ten percent (10%) EBE goal.
- B. <u>Determination of Waiver Requests</u> The Contract Compliance Department of the City of Fort Wayne shall examine all Requests for Waiver to determine if Contractor's efforts constitute good faith efforts to attain such goal and shall submit recommendations concerning said requests for Waiver for the final determination of the Board of Public Works of the City of Fort Wayne.
- C. <u>Good Faith Efforts</u>. In determining whether or not the Contractor used "good faith" efforts, the following shall be considered:

- 1. Whether the contract can be subdivided as determined by the Engineer and Administrator of Contract Compliance;
- 2. Availability of certified EBE businesses to participate as subcontractors;
- 3. Non-competitive price quotes received from EBE firms. The Board of Public Works' determination for granting a reduction or waiver of the goal because of higher quotes from EBE firms will be based on factors that include, but are not limited to the following:
  - a. The Engineer's estimate for the work under a specific contract;
  - b. The Contractor's own estimate for the work under the subcontract;
  - c. An average of the valid prices quoted for the subcontract;
  - d. Demonstrated increase in other contract costs as a result of sub-contracting to EBE firm(s).
- 4. Documented measures taken by the Contractor to comply with the EBE participation goal;
- 5. EBE subcontractor failed to fulfill their obligation in regard to the time delivery of goods and/or services. Also in regards to the quality of the goods and/or services set forth in the bid specifications.
- 6. Such other matters as the Board of Public Works deems relevant.
- D. <u>Consequences of Noncompliance</u> In the event the Board of Public Works approves a recommendation that Contractor failed to make good faith efforts at compliance, the Contract Price shall be reduced by the amount calculated as the difference between the EBE participation goal of 10% and the actual participation level met by the Contractor, but in no case shall it be reduced by more than 5%. Said amount shall be added to the City of Fort Wayne EBE Bond Guarantee Fund and Contractor agrees to accept the reduced amount as full payment under the terms of his/her Contract.
- E. <u>Waiver Approved</u> In the event the Board of Public Works determines that a good faith effort to comply with these EBE participation requirements has been made, the Contract Price shall not be reduced, and the balance owing to the Contractor shall be paid in full.

The contractor shall furnish all labor, insurance, equipment, materials and power for the completion of the project: "Ewing St. East-West Storm Sewer Extension Phase II" as follows: This proposed storm sewer system will consist of the Construction of storm sewer extensions along Broadway, Ewing St., Fairfield Ave., Fulton St., Harrison St., Jefferson Blvd., Washington Blvd. and Webster St. This will consist of approximately 5,983 linear feet of 42", 36", 30", 24", 18", 15" & 12" storm sewer pipe. The storm sewer extensions will pick up existing street and parking lot inlets and catch basins that are currently connected to the combined system. It will also consist of 693 linear feet of 8" water main replacement along Fairfield Avenue, 60 linear feet of water main lowering for the associated storm sewer installation and 255 linear feet of sanitary sewer on Jefferson Boulevard and Webster Street.

<u>Implications of not being approved:</u> Fort Wayne is committed to improving river water quality. Specifically, the combined sewer Long Term Control Plan will involve the investment of nearly \$240 million in projects to improve river water quality. As part of a Consent Decree negotiated with the US EPA and Indiana Department of Environmental Management, Fort Wayne agreed to implement a number of partial sewer separation projects. Separation done by constructing new storm sewers will reduce the amount of storm water entering the combined sewer system.

# If Prior Approval is being Requested, Justify: n/a

This project was advertised to contractors on February 28, 2014, March 7, 2014 in the Journal Gazette and the News Sentinel and February 26, 2014 in Frost Illustrated, Inc.

The contract for Resolution # 75877 awarded to Atlas Excavating, Inc. for \$1,699,246.00 was the lowest most responsive bidder of 4 bidders and 18% below the Engineer's estimate of \$2,064,212,00. The second lowest bidder was \$134,519.20 above Atlas Excavating, Inc.'s bid.
