## SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO.

## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CIVIC CENTER URBAN RENEWAL AREA (CCUR) PARKING GARAGE PROJECT FUND.

- WHEREAS, in September 2013, a transformational public-private downtown project was announced that includes a new national headquarters for Ash Brokerage, a residential component led by Hanning & Bean Enterprises, retail space, and a publicly owned parking garage; and,
- WHEREAS, in October 2013, the Capital Improvement Board approved to provide the City with \$6.5 million over 10 years and the Redevelopment Commission ratified and approved land acquisition costs and a contract for professional architectural/engineering services for the parking garage; and,
- WHERAS, in May 2014, the Capital Improvement Board approved an additional \$4 million to assist with financing the parking garage, the Redevelopment Commission approved the pledge of TIF funds for the development, and the Common Council approved the pledge of \$5 million of Legacy funds for the construction of the parking garage; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Controller believe the multiple sources of funding should be retained in a separate fund to ensure clear accountability of the funding streams for this project.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:
- **SECTION 1.** The Civic Center Urban Renewal Area (CCUR) Parking Garage Project Fund shall be established for the purpose of holding, accounting for, administering and appropriating all funds for this specific project.
