Members of the Common Council;

The Fort Wayne Fire Department is requesting your approval for the purchase of a 100' platform, rear mounted ladder truck from Pierce Manufacturing. The cost of this new truck will be \$914,571.00. This new truck is a "demo" model that can be delivered within 3-4 months, after some minor reconfiguration, instead of the 12 months it would take to build a custom truck. Additionally, the cost of a custom truck that would meet our needs is estimated to cost \$1.2 million. With the purchase of the "demo" truck, the reduced cost of the truck saves the city approximately \$285,000.

Within the Fort Wayne Fire Department, we have 4 ladder trucks (Truck 1, Truck 12, Truck 15 and Truck 19) as well as the Quint, which operates as a truck and an engine. This new ladder truck will replace the truck that is currently assigned to Station 15, which is located at 1415 Northland Blvd. Truck 15 is a 1995 E-One rear mounted 100' platform truck. It was originally scheduled for replacement in 2009.

Once the new truck is placed into service, the E-One ladder truck will be utilized as a reserve piece of equipment, which will be used to fill in while one of our front line trucks is out of service for repairs or scheduled maintenance. Currently, we do not have any reserve trucks in the fleet.

A traditional bid process was not used for this purchase, because this truck is demo it is being purchased directly from Pierce Manufacturing. The funding source for this purchase will be the master lease. I thank you in advance for your consideration regarding this purchase.
