SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. S-____

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CREATION OF A LEASE RENTAL RESERVE FUND FROM THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE COMMUNITY LEGACY FUND.

Whereas, the City of Fort Wayne ("City") has created the City of Fort Wayne Community Legacy Fund ("Legacy Fund") to invest in projects that will have a collective impact that leads to transformational change within the community; and

Whereas, the City through the Legacy process has received unprecedented public input from across the community and has worked with citizens, business leaders and elected officials to develop implementation priorities; and

Whereas, the City seeks to advance transformational projects for our community with a focus on economic development, downtown and riverfront development, and youth development/prep sports; and

Whereas, each Legacy project provides our community with an opportunity to make our City stronger and better positioned for growth; and

Whereas, the Common Council of the City has adopted Special Ordinance No. S-_____ on June 24, 2014 ("Ordinance") to, among other matters, approve (i) the lease dated as of June 1, 2014 (the "Lease") between the Fort Wayne Redevelopment Commission (the "Commission") and the Fort Wayne Redevelopment Authority (the "Authority") which provides for the lease by the Authority to the Commission of certain local public improvements consisting of a parking structure (the "Project") which will support an urban mixed-use building also consisting of the Project, certain office space, certain retail space to be constructed at street level, certain high rise residential space and certain residential townhomes to be constructed at street level and other related improvements and (ii) the issuance of lease rental revenue bonds by the Authority (the "Bonds") to finance

a portion of the costs related to the completion of the Project which upon completion the Authority will lease to the Commission pursuant to the Lease; and

Whereas, the City has been advised that the Commission expects to pay the rentals due under the Lease (the "Lease Rentals") from tax increment revenues (the "TIF Revenues") expected to be collected from the Civic Center Urban Renewal Area previously designated by the Commission as a redevelopment area and an allocation area for purposes of collecting the TIF Revenues, and that the Commission expects the TIF Revenues, along with other revenues to be made available to the Commission, including, without limitation, revenues from the Capital Improvement Board (collectively, the "Revenues"), will be sufficient to provide for the payment of the Lease Rentals when due; and;

Whereas, the City has been advised that in order to provide the lowest interest rate on the Bonds to be issued by the Authority, the Commission must provide for a lease rental reserve fund (the "Lease Reserve Fund") in an amount equal to the maximum amount of Lease Rentals due on July 15 and January 15 of any year during the term of the Lease (the "Lease Reserve Requirement"); and

Whereas, the City has been advised that the Lease Reserve Requirement may be satisfied by using funds already on hand in the Legacy Fund which will maximize the amount of Bond proceeds available to complete the Project; and

Whereas, the City would like to utilize funds from the Legacy Fund to fulfill the Lease Reserve Requirement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The Common Council hereby authorizes the Board of Trustees of the Legacy Fund to instruct the financial institution serving as the trustee of the Legacy Fund to establish a subaccount within the Legacy Fund as follows:

Lease Reserve Fund for the Fort Wayne Redevelopment Authority Lease Rental Revenue Bonds of 2014

Funds in an amount equal to the Lease Reserve Requirement will be held in a subaccount of the Legacy Fund to serve as the Lease Reserve Fund containing the Lease Reserve Requirement. Such funds held as the Lease Reserve Fund in the subaccount shall be used to pay the Lease Rentals in accordance with the Lease only if the Commission does not otherwise have sufficient Revenues to pay such Lease Rentals and may not be used for any other purpose. If any portion of the subaccount is used to pay the Lease Rentals due under the Lease, such subaccount may be replenished by the Commission to a level equal to the Lease Reserve Requirement to the extent TIF Revenues are available for such purpose. If the Lease Reserve Fund is still in need of funds to attain a balance equal to the Lease Reserve Requirement, the Common Council shall consider an appropriation of funds from the Legacy Fund to attain a balance equal to the Lease Reserve Requirement. Such deficiency and an appropriation from the Legacy Fund shall be considered by the Common Council within six months after the deficiency is created.

If the Commission requires funds from the Lease Reserve Fund for the payment of Lease Rentals due under the Lease, a request shall be filed by the Commission with the City's Controller. The City agrees to make funds available to the Commission within one business day of the filing of such request. The request filed with the City's Controller may be made in writing, via e-mail or by phone, followed up either in writing or via e-mail. The request shall state the amount needed from the Lease Reserve Fund to pay the Lease Rentals then due under the Lease.

Upon the final payment of the Lease Rentals by the Commission under the Lease, the subaccount serving as the Lease Reserve Requirement for the Lease Reserve Fund shall cease to exist, and such funds shall remain a part of the Legacy Fund and shall no longer be subject to this ordinance.

If the City determines that the Lease Reserve Requirement can be satisfied with another source of funds available to the Commission and permitted by law to be used for such purpose and such alternative source is indeed funded to serve as all or a part of the Lease Reserve Requirement, the Common Council shall authorize the Board of Trustees of the Legacy Fund to provide instructions to the trustee of the Legacy Fund to modify as necessary, including elimination, the subaccount serving as the Lease Reserve Fund.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.
