Members of the Common Council,

The Fort Wayne Fire Department is requesting your approval for the purchase of a Pierce Arrow XT 105' Heavy Duty Aerial Rear Mounted Ladder Truck (stock #27391). The cost of this truck with modifications will be \$848,580.00. This truck is a "demo" model that if purchased new would cost \$1,025,782.21 and would take at least 12 months to build.

In comparison, the Village of Oak Brook, Ill. recently purchased a Pierce Arrow XT 105' Heavy Duty Aerial in June of last year and paid \$908,700.00. Pierce estimates their annual price increase to be between 3-3.5%.

The truck that you approved for purchase in July cost the city \$908,500 the difference in price between this truck and the last one can be attributed to the style of aerial apparatus. This truck does not have an aerial platform or bucket; instead it has a "straight stick". An aerial platform allows firefighters to operate from the safety of the bucket while an aerial stick allows for a faster means of rescue or egress. In a city of our size it is beneficial to have aerial platforms as well as the straight stick; diversity in our types of aerials offers us more flexibility at the scene of an emergency.

Within the Fort Wayne Fire Department, we have 4 ladder trucks (Truck 1, Truck 12, Truck 15 and Truck 19) as well as the Quint, which operates as a truck and an engine. This new ladder truck will replace the truck that is currently assigned to Station 12, which is located at 6901 South Anthony. Truck 12 is a 2001 Pierce 100' straight stick.

Although nothing changed in the 5 year inspection process, earlier this summer, we experienced an unprecedented amount of failure with our trucks. The purchase of this second demo truck in 2014 will bring our truck fleet back to what I believe is a reasonable level of service. This will be a welcome relief as I look to increase the role of our ladder crews in the emergency response to the city.

Once the new truck is placed into service, the 2001 100' Pierce truck will be utilized as a reserve piece of equipment, which will be used to fill in while one of our front line trucks is out of service for repairs or scheduled maintenance.

The advantages of a demo truck are the cost savings the city will realize and the time of delivery. We will be able to place this truck into service in just a few months as opposed to the year it would take if we ordered one. It is being purchased from Pierce Manufacturing through its Indianapolis dealership Global Emergency Products. The funding source for this purchase will be the master lease.
