

designated for Non-Access Channel Originator Grants, subject to approval by City Council. Any funds not utilized for grants must remain in the fund for use the following year.

The budget for non-access originator grants is \$109,000, which is 10% of "access dollars" and 4% of the total franchise fees collected in the previous four quarters. In addition to funding cable channels and these grants, Cable Franchise Fees also provided about \$1.6 million dollars to the City's general fund in the last 12 months.
