To All City Council Members:

The Fort Wayne Police Department continues to use aircards in our vehicles to wirelessly connect our mobile data computers to the department's information database and computer-aided dispatch center. Each car has a unique aircard and there is a monthly subscription fee per card. In 2015 we will be increasing our number of aircards to include the 61<sup>st</sup> recruit class once they are off of supervised FTO status in November 2015.

The aircard service is a significant improvement over the previous modem-based/ hotspot technology. The aircard service provides increased reliability and faster transaction speeds, thereby allowing us to increase the amount of information we can push out to the squad cars. Many of the speed and connectivity issues that were problematic with hotspot technology have been eliminated.

Officers utilize their mobile car-mounted computers to receive dispatch information, to perform various database inquiries, and to prepare reports that can be electronically routed to the central information repository and to other support agencies. By performing these tasks from their squad car, the officers can minimize their out-of-service time and be available for increased pro-active patrol and follow-up.
