**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne, Division of City Utilities, desires to purchase property located at 701 East Wayne Street, Fort Wayne, Indiana for future reconstruction of the Hanna Street Combined Sewer Overflow Regulator; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne, through its Board of Public Works, has approved the purchase of the property pursuant to Board of Public Works Resolution Number 102-9-9-15-2, Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price for the property is FORTY-FOUR THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND 00/100 DOLLARS – (\$44,500.00); and

WHEREAS, Sec. 37-19 of the City of Fort Wayne Code of Ordinances, requires the Common Council approval of any purchase of real estate by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The purchase of real estate by the City of Fort Wayne by its Division of City Utilities, located at 701 E. Wayne Street,

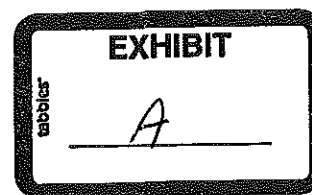

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne (the "City") has an ongoing program of purchasing properties critical to its Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has need for the property located at 701 East Wayne Street for the future reconstruction of the Hanna Street Combined Sewer Overflow Regulator in a location out of the intersection so as to be more safely accessible by maintenance personnel; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to purchase from Gwen N. Parks, LaVerne M. Brown, Teresa Ransom & Steve Ransom the property commonly known as 701 East Wayne Street, Fort Wayne, Indiana, 46802, also known as Part of Lot 371 in Hanna's Addition to the City of Fort Wayne (the "Real Estate") as more particularly described in an "Affidavit For Transfer of Real Estate Without Administration Pursuant to Indiana Code Section 29-1-8-3" recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Allen County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, Gwen N. Parks, LaVerne M. Brown, Teresa Ransom & Steve Ransom have voluntarily elected to sell the Real Estate to the City; and

WHEREAS, the agreed purchase price is Forty Four Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$44,500.00), which is the average of two appraisals as mandated by Indiana statute.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The purchase of the Real Estate by the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, for the price of Forty-Four Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$44,500.00) is hereby approved.

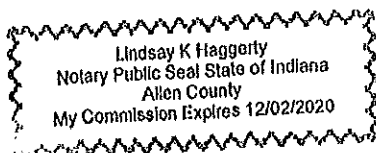

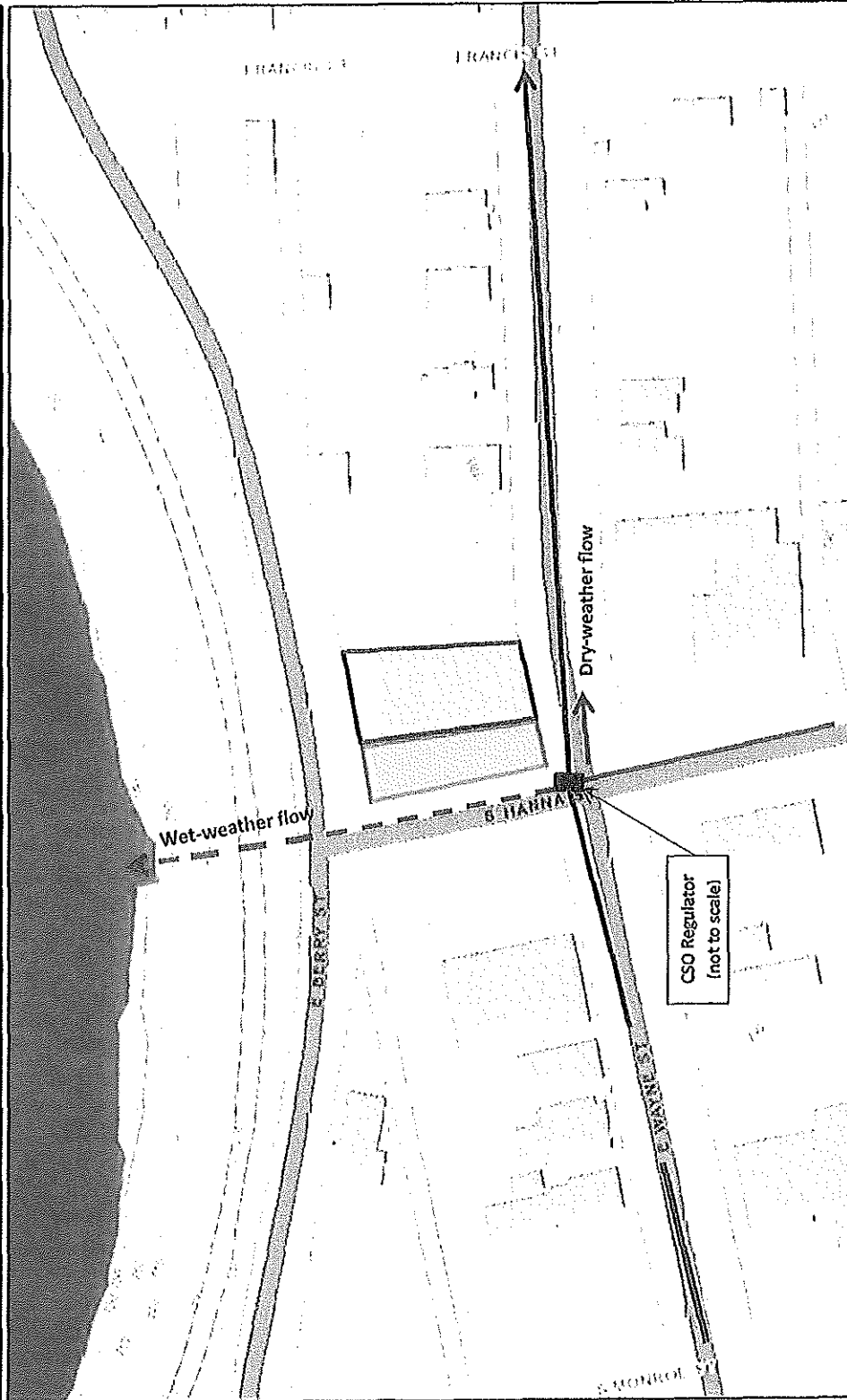

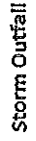


City-owned parcels

Background & supporting information:

City Utilities would like to purchase 701 East Wayne Street for the future reconstruction of the Hanna Street Combined Sewer Overflow Regulator in a location out of the intersection of Wayne and Hanna Streets so as to be more safely accessible by maintenance personnel for debris removal. Presently, the regulator is located in the northeast part of this intersection. Therefore, the property under consideration is in the most suitable location for improving access to the regulator. Also, the City owns the two parcels immediately to the east of this address.

The purchase price is \$44,500.00, which is the average value of the two appraisals obtained. A map is attached to this memo highlighting this property along with a copy of the Resolution approved by the Board of Public Works on September 9, 2015.

Implications of not being approved:

More of the intersection is blocked when the regulator is accessed by maintenance personnel in its present location resulting in increased hazards for both them and motorists. Furthermore, if the property is not purchased, at this time, it will most likely cost more to purchase at a later date as the real estate market returns to its natural rate of increasing real estate values.
