AN ORDINANCE approving the Purchase and Installation of Yearly Maintenance for Police Sentryx software at a total cost of \$105,771 from and through Spillman Technologies, Inc. by the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana.

WHEREAS, Spillman Sentryx Software is used for the Public Safety activities of the Fort Wayne Police Department, the Fort Wayne Fire Department, the Allen County Sherriff's Office, Allen County Juvenile Corrections, the New Haven Police Department, and the IPFW Police Department;

Subject: Yearly Maintenance for Spillman Mobile software

Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to authorize the purchase of yearly maintenance for Sentryx software from Spillman Technologies, Inc for the operation of the City's Public Safety system. This year's cost of maintenance for mobile software is \$105,771.

This is the first time this software maintenance payment has appeared before Council for approval. In previous year, the amount was below the threshold for Council approval.

This payment is part of a group of four payments by the City and County to Spillman Technologies, Inc each year. Allen County and the City of Fort Wayne each pay this amount for the maintenance of the main Spillman Sentryx system. Allen County also pays approximately \$50,000 the maintenance of their mobile software, and Fort Wayne pays \$127,000 for their mobile maintenance.

In exchange for maintenance fees, the software vendors provide support for problems with the software and periodically provide new versions of the software.

Our decision to pay maintenance rests on four tests:

- Do we have a continuing internal commitment to use this software?
- Is the software vendor continuing to improve the product?
- Is the vendor useful in solving problems with the software?
- If the software fails, what's the worst case scenario?

The City and County both have substantial investments in the use of Spillman software. Spillman provides regular updates to the software and supports our day to day operation of the software.

This software is critical to daily work of police, fire, and medical first

responders. Based on these factors, I strongly recommend continued funding of Spillman maintenance.
