DECLARATORY RESOLUTION NO. R-

A DECLARATORY RESOLUTION designating an "Economic Revitalization Area" under I.C. 6-1.1-12.1 for property commonly known as 701 Sherman Boulevard, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46808 (Becky's Die Cutting, Inc.)

WHEREAS, Petitioner has duly filed its petition dated December 9, 2015 to have the following described property designated and declared an "Economic Revitalization Area" under Sections 153.13-153.24 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, and I.C. 6-1.1-12.1, to wit:

Attached hereto as "Exhibit A" as if a part herein;

and

WHEREAS, said project will create one full-time permanent job for a total new, annual payroll of \$25,000, with the average new annual job salary being \$25,000 and retain six full-time permanent jobs and one part-time job for a total current annual payroll of \$180,000, with the average current, annual job salary being \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated project cost is \$156,750; and

WHEREAS, it appears the said petition should be processed to final determination in accordance with the provisions of said Division 6.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1.That, subject to the requirements of Section 6, below, the property hereinabove described is hereby designated and declared an "Economic Revitalization Area" under I.C. 6-1.1-12.1. Said designation shall begin upon the effective date of the Confirming Resolution referred to in Section 6 of this Resolution and shall terminate on December 31, 2016, unless otherwise automatically extended in five year increments per I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-9.

SECTION 2. That, upon adoption of the Resolution:

- (a) Said Resolution shall be filed with the Allen County Assessor;
- (b) Said Resolution shall be referred to the Committee on Finance requesting a recommendation from said committee concerning the advisability of designating the above area an "Economic Revitalization Area";
- (c) Common Council shall publish notice in accordance with I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-2.5 and I.C. 5-3-1 of the adoption and substance of this resolution and setting this designation as an "Economic Revitalization Area" for public hearing.

**SECTION 3.** That, said designation of the hereinabove described property as an "Economic Revitalization Area" shall apply to a deduction of the assessed value of personal property for new manufacturing equipment.

SECTION 4. That, the estimate of the number of individuals that will be employed or whose employment will be retained and the estimate of the annual salaries of those individuals and the estimate of the value of new manufacturing equipment, all contained in Petitioner's Statement of Benefits, are reasonable and are benefits that can be reasonably expected to result from the proposed described installation of new manufacturing equipment.

SECTION 5. That, the current year approximate tax rates for taxing units within the City would

- (a) If the proposed new manufacturing equipment is not installed, the approximate current year tax rates for this site would be \$3.5329/\$100.
- (b) If the proposed new manufacturing equipment is installed and no deduction is granted, the approximate current year tax rate for the site would be \$3.5329/\$100 (the change would be negligible).
- (c) If the proposed new manufacturing equipment is installed and a deduction percentage of eighty percent (80%) is assumed, the approximate current year tax rate for the site would be \$3.5329/\$100 (the change would be negligible).

**SECTION 6.** That, this Resolution shall be subject to being confirmed, modified and confirmed, or rescinded after public hearing and receipt by Common Council of the above described recommendations and resolution, if applicable.

**SECTION 7.** That, pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-12.1, it is hereby determined that the deduction from the assessed value of the new manufacturing equipment shall be for a period of three years.

**SECTION 8.** The deduction schedule from the assessed value of new manufacturing equipment pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-17 shall look like this:

**SECTION 9.** That, the benefits described in the Petitioner's Statement of Benefits can be reasonably expected to result from the project and are sufficient to justify the applicable deductions.

**SECTION 10.** That, the taxpayer is non-delinquent on any and all property tax due to jurisdictions within Allen County, Indiana.

SECTION 11. That, pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-12 et al, any property owner that has received a deduction under section 3 or 4.5 of said chapter may be required to repay the deduction amount as determined by the county auditor in accordance with section 12 of said chapter if the property owner ceases operations at the facility for which the deduction was granted and if the Common Council finds that the property owner obtained the deduction by intentionally providing false information concerning the property owner's plans to continue operation at the facility.

**SECTION 12.** That, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.

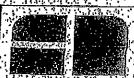

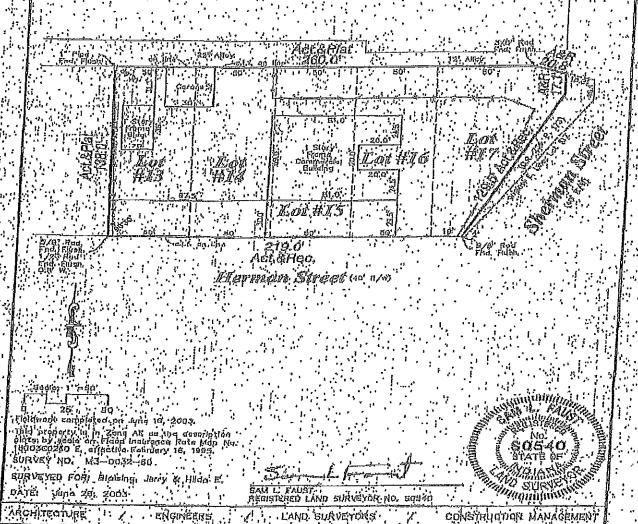

#### Per the policy of the City of Fort Wayne, the following guidelines apply to this project:

1. The period of deduction for personal property is three years.

Under Fort Wayne Common Council's tax abatement policies and procedures, Becky's Die Cutting Inc. is eligible for a three deduction on personal property improvements. Attached is a spreadsheet that shows how the application scored under the review system. Also attached is a calculation of property taxes saved/paid with the deduction.

#### Comments

In working with Becky's Die Cutting, Inc. to fill out their designation application, the company informed division staff that equipment had been purchased and installed for which they wanted to have designated for property tax phase-in. Fort Wayne Common Council's property tax phase-in policies and procedures requires an economic revitalization area designation application be filed with the division and approved PRIOR to the installation of equipment. To allow an economic revitalization area designation application to be processed after installation of equipment, a waiver of non-compliance needs to be requested. Indiana Code 6-1.1-12.1-11.3 permits adoption of a resolution to waive non-compliance due to failure to file the Statement of Benefits (SB-1) in the appropriate timeframe. The confirming resolution for this project contains language to waive non-compliance that will allow for the final approval of an economic revitalization area designation on this property for tax, phase-in.
