DECLARATORY RESOLUTION OF THE FORT WAYNE REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION, GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, DEPARTMENT OF REDEVELOPMENT, AMENDING AND RESCINDING THE BAKER STREET URBAN RENEWAL AREA AND ITS ACCOMPANYING TAX ALLOCATION AREA

WHEREAS, on September 21, 1992, the Fort Wayne Redevelopment Commission adopted Confirmatory Resolution 92-70 that confirmed, established and approved the Baker Street Urban Renewal Area (URA) and its accompanying Tax allocation Area; and

WHEREAS, following a period of study and after coordination with the Allen County Auditor and other City staff, Commission staff recommends that the Commission amend the aforesaid Baker Street Station Urban Renewal Area and its accompanying Tax Allocation Area by rescinding Confirmatory Resolution 92-70 in its entirety, and;

WHEREAS, the provisions enabling the collection of tax increment, I.C. 36-7-14-39 were never engaged for the aforesaid tax allocation area and, as such, has no fund balance; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with state statute, the process of amending an urban renewal or economic development area shall be followed by this body which includes a determination by the Fort Wayne City Plan Commission that this amendment is in conformity with the plan of development for the unit (Plan It Allen), approval by the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, publication of a legal public hearing and a final determination (confirmatory resolution) by the Commission thereafter and;

WHEREAS, following the adoption of a confirmatory resolution amending and thereby rescinding Confirmatory Resolution 92-70, no powers of the Commission granted by I.C. 36-7-14 shall be applicable to the aforesaid URA; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Fort Wayne Redevelopment Commission, Governing Body of the City of Fort Wayne, Department of Redevelopment, that

1. Declaratory Resolution 2016-XX is hereby approved. Staff shall submit a copy of this resolution to the Fort Wayne City Plan Commission and thereafter to the Common Council of the City of Wayne for due consideration accordingly.



## **MEMORANDUM**

RE: Rescission of Economic Development Areas and Urban Renewal Area (EDA/URA)

DT: July 15, 2016

On May 9, 2016, the Fort Wayne Redevelopment Commission adopted Resolutions 2016-36, 2016-37 and 2016-38, copies attached, which propose to rescind the Washington Center Coldwater Road EDA, Moeller Meyer Road EDA and Baker Street URA. These entities ("TIF Districts") were created in 1989, 2002 and 1992.

The provisions of the Washington Center Coldwater Road Economic Development Area plan have been fulfilled and the Commission has determined that the powers enabled by statute are no longer needed. The provisions of the Moeller Meyer Road Economic Development Plan were never engaged or implemented due to a key element of the project never materializing. The provisions of the Baker Street URA were never engaged due to alternate sources of funding being used to stabilize the station when it was under City ownership.

Pursuant to I.C. 36-7-14-16 and 36-7-14-41, the Plan Commission determined that these resolutions and action contemplated are in in general conformity to the plan of development for the City of Fort Wayne (Plan It Allen) at its business meeting on June 13, 2016 per the attached resolution. In order for these actions to move forward, each must be approved by the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne. As such, the purpose of this memo is to request that consideration of these resolutions (attached hereto) be made by City Council. If approved, these resolutions will be presented to the Redevelopment Commission for final consideration following a legal public hearing.
