A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING SUBSTANTIAL COMPLIANCE OR NON-COMPLIANCE with Statement of Benefits (CF-1) form filing for 2016 for Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) for property at 3310 West Coliseum Boulevard under Confirming Resolution R-03-14 with an "Economic Revitalization Area" approved under I.C. 6-1.1-12.1

WHEREAS, Common Council has previously designated and declared by Declaratory Resolution and Confirming Resolution with approved Statement of Benefits (SB-1) forms property for Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) as an "Economic Revitalization Area" under Sections 153.13-153.24 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, and I.C. 6-1.1-12.1; and

WHEREAS, property owners whose Statement of Benefits (SB-1) form was approved after July 1, 1991 who file a deduction application under Sections 3 and 4.5 of I.C. 6-1.1-12.1 and Section 153.21 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, must file a Compliance with Statement of Benefits Form (CF-1) with the Allen County Auditor, the Allen County Assessor and the City of Fort Wayne showing information on the extent to which there has been compliance with the approved Statement of Benefits for the project; and

WHEREAS, Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) has filed Compliance with Statement of Benefit Forms with the Allen County Auditor's Office and the City of Fort Wayne; and

WHEREAS, Vermeer of Indiana, Inc.'s (filed under JSC, LLC) approved Statement of Benefits (SB-1) form stated that **six** full-time jobs would be retained and **three** full-time and **one** part-time job would be created by March 2015; and

WHEREAS, Vermeer of Indiana, Inc.'s (filed under JSC, LLC) approved Statement of Benefits (SB-1) form stated \$4300,000 in annual payroll for the six full-time retained jobs and \$205,000 in annual payroll would be generated by the three full-time and one part-time job to be created; and

WHEREAS, Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC); 2016 Compliance with Statement of Benefits (CF-1) form filing stated that **six** jobs were retained and **zero** jobs were created; and

WHEREAS, Vermeer of Indiana, Inc.'s (filed under JSC, LLC); 2016 Compliance with Statement of Benefits (CF-1) form filing stated \$410,000 in annual payroll for the six jobs retained and \$0 in annual payroll for the zero jobs created; and

WHEREAS, Common Council designated the City of Fort Wayne Community Development Division as the entity for the administration, application, processing and monitoring of Economic Revitalization Areas under Section 153.13 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne; and

WHEREAS, Common Council has defined substantial compliance under Section 153.21 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne as:

- Meeting 75% or more of the numbers of full-time and/or part-time jobs stated to be created or retained as delineated in the original Statement of Benefits Form (SB-1) approved by Common Council; and
- Meeting 75% or more of the total payroll stated to be created or retained as delineated in the original Statement of Benefits Form (SB-1) approved by Common Council; and

WHEREAS, meeting 75% of the six full-time jobs retained means retaining four jobs; and

WHEREAS, meeting 75% of the **three** full-time and one part-time job to be created means creating **three** jobs; and

WHEREAS, meeting 75% of the \$430,000 in retained annual payroll means \$322,500 in annual payroll; and

WHEREAS, meeting 75% of the \$205,000 in annual payroll to be created means \$153,750; and

WHEREAS, Common Council made a determination on June 28, 2016 that Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) was not in substantial compliance as a result of its failure to generate at least three jobs and at least \$153,750 in annual payroll created, and that the failure to substantially comply was not caused by factors beyond the control of Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC); and

WHEREAS, Council directed the Community Development Division to mail written notice to Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) explaining the reasons for Council's determination and a date, time, place of a hearing to be conducted by Council for the purpose of further considering Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) compliance with Statement of Benefits; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned notice was properly prepared and served upon Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) on August 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Council conducted a hearing on August 23, 2016 for the purpose of further considering Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) compliance with statement of benefits; and

WHEREAS, Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) appeared/failed to appear at the hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1a. Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) failed to appear and otherwise testify and therefore Council confirms its determination of June 28, 2016 that Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) has failed to substantially comply pursuant to IC 6-1.1-12.1 and Section 153.21 of the Municipal Code of the City of Fort Wayne for its failure to create 75% of the three full-time and one part-time jobs or three jobs that were stated that would be created and create 75% of the \$205,000 in annual payroll or \$1533,750 that was stated that would be generated by the created jobs. Council therefore finds that Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) has failed to substantially comply and said failure was not caused by factors outside of Vermeer of Indiana, Inc.'s (filed under JSC, LLC) control. As a result of said failure, Vermeer of Indiana, Inc.'s (filed under JSC, LLC) deduction/abatement under R-03-14 is hereby terminated.

SECTION 1b. That Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) appeared and testified at the hearing and from its testimony it was determined that notwithstanding Vermeer of Indiana, Inc.'s (filed under JSC, LLC) failure to substantially comply by its failure to create 75% of the three full-time and one part-time job or three jobs that were stated that would be created and create 75% of the \$205,000 in annual payroll or \$153,750 that was stated that would be generated by the created jobs, that Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) did make reasonable efforts to substantially comply with the statement of benefits and Vermeer of Indiana, Inc.'s (filed under JSC, LLC) failure to substantially comply was caused by factors beyond the control of Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC). Therefore the continuation of Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) deduction/abatement under R-03-14 is hereby approved.

SECTION 1c. That Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) appeared and testified at the hearing and from its testimony it was determined that notwithstanding Vermeer of Indiana, Inc.'s (filed under JSC, LLC) failure to substantially comply by its failure to create 75% of the three full-time and one part-time job or three jobs that were stated that would be created and create 75% of the \$205,000 in annual payroll or \$153,750 that was stated that would be generated by the created jobs, that Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC) did not make reasonable efforts to substantially comply with the statement of benefits and Vermeer of Indiana, Inc.'s. (filed under JSC, LLC) failure to substantially comply

was not caused by factors beyond the control of Vermeer of Indiana, Inc. (filed under JSC, LLC). As a result of said failure, Vermeer of Indiana, Inc.'s (filed under JSC, LLC) deduction/abatement under R-03-14 is hereby terminated.

SECTION 2. That, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.
