AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 38 OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE CODE OF ORDINANCES ADDING §38.07 PUBLIC RECORDS; CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION AND ADDING §38.08 USE OF PUBLIC RECORDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne ("City") receives public records requests pursuant to Indiana's Access to Public Records Act, IC § 5-14-3.

WHEREAS, some of the public records requested contain trade secrets, defined by IC §24-2-3-2 as "information, including a formula, pattern, compilation, program, device, method, technique, or process, that: (1) derives independent economic value, actual or potential, from not being generally known to, and not being readily ascertainable by proper means by, other persons who can obtain economic value from its disclosure or use; and (2) is the subject of efforts that are reasonable under the circumstances to maintain its secrecy".

WHEREAS, trade secrets must be withheld as confidential, pursuant to Indiana Code §5-14-3 and §24-2-3.

WHEREAS, City strives for transparency but must also abide by nondisclosure requirements of trade secrets pursuant to Indiana Code.

WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly has determined that it is good public policy to exempt public records from being used for the

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involuntary solicitation, advertisement, or sale of merchandise, goods or services from and to City's residents and businesses.

WHEREAS, the City strives to balance the public interest in transparent government with the need to protect residents' and businesses' privacy.

WHEREAS, certain requesters request information pertaining to residents and businesses within the City in order to sell, advertise and/or solicit the purchase of merchandise, goods, or services.

WHEREAS, City residents and businesses have informed City staff that they do not want their information to be disclosed for the purpose of being contacted regarding the sale, advertisement or solicitation of goods and services.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne now finds it is in the best interest of the residents and businesses of the City to prohibit an individual, corporation, limited liability company, partnership or unincorporated association who receives public information from using the information received for purposes of selling, advertising, or soliciting the purchase of merchandise, goods, or services or to sell, loan, give away, or otherwise deliver the information for these purposes, pursuant to IC §5-14-3-3(d).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The following Sections of Chapter 38 be added as follows:

SECTION 38.07. Public records; confidentiality of information.

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Public records requests shall be submitted to the City of Fort Wayne Law Department. All files, records and data of the City of Fort Wayne shall be open to reasonable public inspection in accordance with applicable Indiana law. However, upon request by any person to the City of Fort Wayne Law Department and a showing satisfactory by any person that the files, records and data contain information which would, if made public, divulge methods or processes entitled to protection as trade secrets of such person or entity, the City of Fort Wayne shall maintain the confidentiality of the information. However, any information accorded confidential treatment under this section may be disclosed or transmitted to other officers, employees, or authorized representatives of the City of Fort Wayne, the State of Indiana or the United States concerned with carrying out or implementing this chapter or when relevant in any proceeding related to enforcement.

SECTION 38.08 Use of public records.

Any individual, corporation, limited liability company, partnership or unincorporated association who receives public information on a disc or tape under IC §5-14-3-3(d) may not use the information for commercial purposes, including to sell, advertise, or solicit the purchase of merchandise, goods, or services, or sell, loan, give away, or otherwise deliver the information obtained by the request to any other individual, corporation, limited liability company, partnership or unincorporated association for these purposes; provided, however, such information may be used in connection with the preparation or publication of news, for nonprofit activities, or for academic research. An individual, corporation, limited liability company, partnership or unincorporated association who uses information in a manner contrary to this

provision may be prohibited from obtaining a copy or any further data under IC §5-14-3-3(d). SECTION 2. Except for the foregoing amendments, the remaining sections of Chapter 38 of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect. SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor. Council Introduction Date: September 27, 2016

Background & Supporting Information:

City departments receive hundreds of public records requests each year. Some requests are for documents containing trade secrets. Trade secrets are prohibited by law to be disseminated through a public records request response, but City has received some pushback from requesters who want the information. This Ordinance states clearly to all requesters that trade secret information will be kept confidential and also puts requesters on notice that all requests should be made to the City Law Department.

Some requests are from out of state companies requesting resident and business information so that they can solicit, advertise and/or sell goods and services to Fort Wayne residents, businesses and customers. City staff have received feedback from these residents, businesses and customers who have stated they do not want their information, most which they deem private, given to these companies and do not want to be solicited for goods and services just because they are a resident, business or customer of Fort Wayne.
