GENERAL ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 52: WATER AND WATERCOURCES CITY OF FORT WAYNE, CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana approved water rate adjustments on May 14, 2013 via Amended Ordinance G-6-13 to reflect rates approved by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) in Tariff Number 44162;and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission subsequently reviewed and approved revised rates to be charged by the Fort Wayne water utility to the City of New Haven, which resulted in the IURC issuing a revised tariff that includes adjusted rates to be applied to all other water utility customers and to be known as Schedule of Phase IV Rates and Charges; and

WHEREAS, the revised rates (Phase IV) contained herein will still fully fund the previously developed Capital Improvements Plan (CIP) allowing the Water Utility to continue to provide its customers with safe, reliable and affordable drinking water through sustainable levels of capital spending on treatment facilities' parts and equipment, field maintenance equipment, water main replacement and other structures and facilities positioned throughout the service territory; and

WHEREAS, the revised rate schedule has been reviewed by the Board of Public Works of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, which finds that the rate schedule contained herein is sufficient to generate funds to meet the other fiscal needs of the Fort Wayne water utility including:

- (A) Payment of all of the legal and other necessary expenses incident to the operation of the utility;
- (B) Provision of a sinking fund, a debt service reserve, adequate money for working capital and making extensions and replacements to the extent not provided for through depreciation;

Council Introduction Date: January 10, 2017

In 2012, City Council and the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("IURC") approved water rates adjustments to be implemented in three phases – effective January 1 of 2013, 2014, and 2015, respectively. Subsequently, the IURC reviewed and approved revised water rates to be charged to New Haven, which resulted in the IURC issuing a revised tariff adjusting rates to be applied to all other water utility customers. For a typical residential retail customer of City Utilities, these adjustments result in a 14 cent decrease to the monthly water bill.

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA

AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 100-4-24-13-1

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works recommended and the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana approved water rate adjustments on May 14, 2013 via General Ordinance G-13-04-20 to reflect rates approved by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) via Tariff Number 44162 on December 18, 2013, said rates to be implemented by City Utilities in three phases effective on January 1, 2013, 2014 and 2015 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the IURC subsequently reviewed and adjusted water rates to be charged to the City of New Haven and all other City Utilities water customers and issued a revised Tariff Number 44162 on December 1, 2016 containing a "Schedule of Phase IV Rates and Charges"; and

WHEREAS, the Phase IV rates and charges contained herein are based on the IURC's revised Tariff 44162 and will still fully fund the previously developed Capital Improvements Plan (CIP) allowing the Fort Wayne water utility to continue to provide its customers with safe, reliable and affordable drinking water through sustainable levels of capital spending on treatment facilities' parts and equipment, field maintenance equipment, water main replacement and other structures and facilities positioned throughout the service territory; and

WHEREAS, the revised Tariff includes water rates that will generate sufficient funds to meet the other fiscal needs of the Fort Wayne water utility including:

- (A) Payment of all of the legal and other necessary expenses incident to the operation of the utility;
- (B) Provision of a sinking fund, a debt service reserve, adequate money for working capital and making extensions and replacements to the extent not provided for through depreciation;
- (C) Provision of money for the payment of any taxes that may be assessed against the utility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Public Works of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana finds that the revised water utility rates and charges

listed below have been approved by the IURC via Tariff No. 44162 and are necessary to provide sufficient revenue to maintain the Utility's property in a sound physical and financial condition to render adequate and efficient service and to fund the Utility's CIP, which adjustment will produce fair and just rates for such services and improvements; and

Be it further resolved that the Board of Public Works recommends that the Common Council act in accordance with I.C. 8-1.5-3-8 and find and elect that the rates and charges for water service to be paid by users of the system should be sufficient to carry out the obligations of the water utility as outlined above, to provide a fair and reasonable return on the utility plant of the City of Fort Wayne and to compensate the City for taxes that would be due to the City on the Utility property were it privately owned; and

Be it further resolved that the Board of Public Works does hereby recommend that the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne amend Chapter 52 of the Fort Wayne Code of Ordinances to adjust the rates and charges assessed to Fort Wayne water utility customers as approved by the IURC via Tarriff No. 44162 as shown below and that the revised rates be implemented by City Utilities effective on January 1, 2017.
