
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ANCILLARY SERVICES FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne (the "City"), by and through the Fort Wayne Fire Department (the "FWFD"), is a first responder to medical emergencies throughout the City but presently provides only Basic Life Support ("BLS") services; and,

WHEREAS, the FWFD is prepared to become certified to provide Advanced Life Support ("ALS") and to staff FWFD engines with firefighter paramedics and Advanced EMTs who can provide ALS; and,

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2016 an Agreement for Enhancement of First Responder Services was signed by the City and Three Rivers Ambulance Authority (the "Authority"); and,

WHEREAS, by January 1, 2017, the Authority will pay a one-time non-repayable grant to the City for the purchase of equipment and related costs; and,

WHEREAS, beginning January 1, 2017, and by January 1 of each year thereafter, the Authority will pay \$400,000.00 to the City as long as the Authority serves as the administrator of ambulance services in the City to be used to certify and train firefighter paramedics and to equip and staff engines to provide ALS service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. The Ancillary Services Fund shall be established for the purpose of accounting for the receipts and payments related to the said agreement between the City of Fort Wayne and the Three Rivers Ambulance Authority.
