Subject: Annual fees for 3G & 4G Broadband access for Public Safety vehicles

Members of City Council:

The reason for this purchase is to allow computers in Public Safety vehicles to communicate with 911 dispatch and other public safety vehicles.

This ordinance will authorize the annual purchase of 3G & 4G Broadband access for Public Safety from Verizon Wireless for communication with the City's police vehicles. This year's cost of maintenance for telephone software is \$140,000. The service will cover approximately 385 vehicles.

The cost per unit \$29.99 per month and provides full speeds for up to 5gb of data per month.

The Indiana Office of Technology periodically enters into contracts to provide quantity purchase agreements for units of government in Indiana. The prices for this purchase are based on Contract #09847, Amendment #9.

The prices in this contract were the same as prices in similar Indiana Office of Technology contracts with Sprint and AT&T. Due the substance cost in officer time and money of switching service providers, I recommend continued use of Verizon Wireless for 3G & 4G Broadband access on the City's public safety vehicles.
