BE IT ORDAINED by the Local Income Tax Council of Allen County, Indiana that a need now exists to modify the local income tax rates imposed within the county in the following way:

Local Income Tax Type	Existing Rate	Proposed Rate
Expenditure Rate (IC 6-3.6-6)	0.9821%	Not to exceed total 1.1321%, consisting of: 0.10% public safety allocation; 0.4821% certified shares; and economic development allocation not to exceed 0.55%

The local income tax rates proposed above will become effective on October 1, 2017. The local income tax rates proposed above will remain in effect until modified or repealed by Allen County Local Income Tax Council. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that public hearings were held on the proposed local income tax rate modifications on June 27, 2017 and July 11, 2017.
