AN ORDINANCE approving the purchase of software for uniform crime reporting at a total cost of \$120,335 from and through Spillman Technologies, Inc. by the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana.

**WHEREAS**, the City has received a grant of \$120,335 from NCS-X, the National Crime Statistics Exchange;

WHEREAS, the grant is directed to be used for the software to facilitate the Uniform Crime Reports for the National Incident-Based Reporting System;

WHEREAS, in two years the use of standard crime reporting software will be mandatory for all public law enforcement agencies across the nation;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the purchase of the Spillman NIBRS (National Incident-Based Reporting System) module, the Spillman Learning Management System, and software maintenance for these systems from Spillman Technologies, Inc. for a total of cost to the City of \$120,335 is hereby approved in all respects.

**SECTION 2.** That the City is authorized and directed to take all action necessary for the purchase of this system by and through Spillman Technologies, Inc.

10	This ordinance is to authorize the purchase of the Spillman NIBRS (National
11	Incident-Based Reporting System) module, the Spillman Learning
12	Management System, and software maintenance for these systems.
13	Through the work of Officer Scott Kizziar, Officer Rick Wurm, and the Director of Public Safety grant Deb Morrone, the city has received a received a grant of
14	\$120,335 from NCS-X, the National Crime Statistics Exchange. In two years
15	the use of standard crime reporting software will be mandatory for all public law enforcement agencies across the nation. Since Fort Wayne agreed to be
16	a pilot city for this software, we were awarded this federal grant to purchase the software.

18	This grant will cover the cost of the modules and two years of annual maintenance for the modules. In subsequent years the additional annual
19	maintenance cost is \$11,835.
20	The software modules will become part of the larger Spillman public safety computer system, and be available to all the local public safety units that share
21	it.
