3 **AN ORDINANCE** approving the purchase of
4 software for uniform crime reporting at a total cost
5 of \$120,335 from and through Spillman
6 Technologies, Inc. by the City of Fort Wayne,
Indiana,

7 **WHEREAS**, the City has received a grant of
8 \$120,335 from NCS-X, the National Crime Statistics Exchange;

9 **WHEREAS**, the grant is directed to be used for the
10 software to facilitate the Uniform Crime Reports for the National
Incident-Based Reporting System;

11 **WHEREAS**, in two years the use of standard crime
12 reporting software will be mandatory for all public law
enforcement agencies across the nation;

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON**
15 **COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:**

17 **SECTION 1.** That the purchase of the Spillman NIBRS (National
18 Incident-Based Reporting System) module, the Spillman Learning
19 Management System, and software maintenance for these systems from
20 Spillman Technologies, Inc. for a total of cost to the City of \$120,335 is hereby
21 approved in all respects.

24 action necessary for the purchase of this system by and through Spillman
25 Technologies, Inc.

10 System)

11 Members of City Council:

12 This ordinance is to authorize the purchase of the Spillman NIBRS (National
13 Incident-Based Reporting System) module, the Spillman Learning
14 Management System, and software maintenance for these systems.

15 Through the work of Officer Scott Kizziar, Officer Rick Wurm, and the Director
16 of Public Safety grant Deb Morrone, the city has received a received a grant of
17 \$120,335 from NCS-X, the National Crime Statistics Exchange. In two years
18 the use of standard crime reporting software will be mandatory for all public
19 law enforcement agencies across the nation. Since Fort Wayne agreed to be
20 a pilot city for this software, we were awarded this federal grant to purchase
21 the software.

22 This grant will cover the cost of the modules and two years of annual
23 maintenance for the modules. In subsequent years the additional annual
24 maintenance cost is \$11,835.

25 The software modules will become part of the larger Spillman public safety
26 computer system, and be available to all the local public safety units that share
27 it.
