A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE & EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT

Whereas, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency has awarded a Staffing for Adequate Fire & Equipment Response (SAFER) Grant to the Fort Wayne Fire Department in the amount of One Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Six Dollars (\$1,350,446);

Whereas, the SAFER program was created to provide funding to fire departments to help increase the number of trained, front-line firefighters available in their communities;

Whereas, grant funds will be used to cover a portion of the salaries and benefits for ten (10) firefighter positions;

Whereas, the grant requires local match funding over a 36-month grant period;

Whereas, the City would commit to accept and expend the SAFER grant funds for their intended purpose;
