10 Comprehensive fee, fine and penalty schedule, be amended as follows:

11 **§ 41.07 COMPREHENSIVE FEE, FINE AND PENALTY SCHEDULE.**

12 (A) The following are fees, fines and penalties assessed by various City of Fort
13 Wayne, Indiana Departments.

14 (B) IC 5-14-3-8 allows the Departments of the City of Fort Wayne to assess various fees for the
15 collection, reproduction and dissemination of information when requested by the public:

Re: Indiana Law Change on Notaries

Summary

Pursuant to a new change in Indiana law, specifically I.C. § 33-42-14-1, a notary public may now charge a fee of not more than ten dollars (\$10) for notarial acts. The Fort Wayne Police Department currently provides this service and will be increasing their service fee to \$10.
