## 

 A RESOLUTION REQUESTING A CHANGE IN THE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION REQUEST BY THE FORT WAYNE CITY COUNCIL FOR RESOLUTION A-19-08-06

WHEREAS, the duly elected Fort Wayne City Council is the fiscal body for the City of Fort Wayne; and

WHEREAS, on May 15' 2019, the City of Fort Wayne Controller's Office was informed that there would be a one-time supplemental distribution of \$3.86 million from the state of Indiana from income taxes above what was budgeted; and

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2019, the \$3.86 million was deposited into City of Fort Wayne accounts; and

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2019, a press conference was held outlining specific initiatives that had been determined without consultation of or participation by Council; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-4-7-8 allows for the legislative body to decrease any additional appropriation only; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2019 when the additional appropriation, A-19-08-06, was brought before the Fort Wayne City Council, there was a vote to hold until the FY 2020 budget is presented and appropriate action may then be taken; and

WHEREAS, \$1,250,000 has already been struck from the additional appropriation by vote of Council and is available to be allocated elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, several of the initiatives outlined in the original appropriation are generally supported by the members of Council; and

WHEREAS, the members of Council generally agree that this process would be better served by collaboration and wish to actively participate in the decision-making process for the re-allocation of the \$1,250,000, with further consideration in other areas, including, but not limited to: doubling the planned allocation to the Neighborhood Partnerships, funding additional infrastructure projects through the City's cost-share program, funding towards comprehensive planning by the City, additional resources for fighting opiate addiction, and funding a City Utility cost-share programming; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the Mayor sign off on this resolution as a show of good faith and solidarity in this collaborative process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1	Section 1. The Fort Wayne City Council requests that the \$1,250,000 proposed as part of
2	A-19-08-06 be re-submitted as part of an improved appropriation request, including an additional
3	\$1,000,000 of funding for the Neighborhood Partnerships.

5	Section 2. That further allocations in the proposal be discussed with members of Council
6	before such a time that it is submitted for consideration no later than the September 24, 2019.

8	SECTION 3. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its
9	passage and approval by the Mayor.
