A RESOLUTION withdrawing bill number G-19-09-30 and defining future responsibilities

WHEREAS, G-19-09-30 and G-19-09-31 were introduced by the Fort Wayne Common Council on September 24, 2019; and

WHEREAS, since introduction, numerous discussions have occurred and opinions have been shared regarding said bills and, in particular, the best way to accomplish the goals set forth in G-19-09-30; and

WHEREAS, at this time, passage G-19-09-30 has been deemed to not be the most effective way to accomplish the best possible administrative outcome; and

WHEREAS, the Fort Wayne Common Council, in conjunction with the Fort Wayne Fire Department and Mayor's staff have a vested interest in a successful outcome that fully defines policies and procedures for the Fire Department Command and Merit Commission which would better represent a fair process to avoid appearance of impropriety; and

WHEREAS, Common Council wishes to amend certain procedures with the input from the Fort Wayne Fire Department and the Professional Fire Fighters Union;

WHEREAS, with passage of G-19-09-31 and mutual agreement of the Fort Wayne Fire Department Administration and Professional Fire Fighters Union to work towards amendment of the procedures as set forth above, Councilman Barranda as sponsor of G-19-09-30 is agreeable to pulling said bill from current consideration.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA,

SECTION 1. Previously introduced G-19-09-30 shall be pulled from consideration by Common Council.

SECTION 2. It is expected that no later than **(DATE CERTAIN)** the Fort Wayne Fire Department Administration, in conjunction with the Fort Wayne Professional Fire Fighters Union and Fire Department Command and Merit Commission, will provide revised procedures reflecting limited promotion discretion and deviation from the toprated candidate.
