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3 **A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS FROM THE**
4 **CITY OF FORT WAYNE COMMUNITY LEGACY FUND**

5 **Whereas**, the City of Fort Wayne has created the City of Fort Wayne
6 Community Legacy Fund to invest in projects that will have a collective impact
7 that leads to transformational change within the community, and;

8 **Whereas**, the City of Fort Wayne through the Legacy process has
9 received unprecedented public input from across the community and has worked
10 with citizens, business leaders and elected officials to develop implementation
11 priorities, and;

12 **Whereas**, the City of Fort Wayne seeks to advance transformational
13 projects for our community with a focus on economic development, downtown
14 and riverfront development, and youth development, and;

15 **Whereas**, each Legacy project provides our community with an
16 opportunity to make our City stronger and better positioned for growth, and;

17 **Whereas**, by working together, we will leave a lasting Legacy for future
18 generations, and;

19 **Whereas**, the bill's sponsor believes that human capital is the highest
20 form of capital investment, and;

21 **Whereas**, approval of use and distribution of Legacy Funds requires a
22 vote in the affirmative of six (6) members of Common Council and approval by
23 the Mayor.

24 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL**
25 **OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:**

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27 **SECTION 1:** The City of Fort Wayne Common Council hereby authorizes
28 the Board of Trustees of the City of Fort Wayne Community Legacy Fund to
29 distribute a portion of the funds to the following project:
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Questa Education Foundation

Funds in the amount of \$800,000.00 will be provided from the City of Fort Wayne Community Legacy Fund to Questa Education Foundation, with a structure of \$200,000.00 per year over the course of four years.

SECTION 2: The Community Development division of the City of Fort Wayne is directed to administer the grant in a timely and appropriate manner upon passage and necessary approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a vote of six members of Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
