WHEREAS, the opioid epidemic has had a severe and detrimental impact on communities across the United States; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne has also experienced and continues to experience the negative impact and costs of the opioid epidemic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne and the community are fighting a costly battle against the opioid epidemic on many fronts; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Wayne has chosen through litigation to pursue those parties it holds responsible for the epidemic; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the City of Fort Wayne maximize the resources available to combat this problem in our community; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

The City of Fort Wayne, having given careful consideration to the decision whether to elect to opt out of the opioid settlement under Indiana Code 4-16-15-2, hereby exercises its election to opt out of the opioids settlement, and orders its duly authorized agent to submit a certified copy of this resolution to the Indiana Attorney General by June 30, 2021.
