Whereas, the simplifying our existing software infrastructure will reduce the complexity of our environment, reduce response time to emergency patches, provide better login security, and enhance our user's experience;

Whereas, these enhancements will make deploying new equipment faster and more automated;

Whereas, the City of Fort Wayne, City Utilities, and Allen County wish to jointly contract and share the cost of upgrading our authentication and email services through KSM Consulting.

Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to authorize the purchase of a contract to upgrade software and servers related to our authentication and email services for the joint City and County computing environment. The cost of this services contract to the City is \$144,300. Allen County will also contribute \$96,200 toward their share of this contract. The total contract will not exceed \$240,500. The total cost may be as low as \$190,365.

Here's a summary of improvements we expect to achieve:

- Users can use their personal 365 accounts on mobile devices with City 365 accounts.
- Faster Office 365 migrations for existing employees
- Faster deployment and equipment swaps for employees
- Better login security, like multi-factor authentication
- A simpler email environment to make us harder to hack
- More training on office applications and security

This enhancement of part of a larger security review we've undertaken in 2021 and is one of our focus area priorities.
