AN ORDINANCE PARTIALLY REPEALING CHAPTER 121: SEXUALLY ORIENTED BUSINESSES, of the **Fort Wayne Municipal Code of Ordinances**

WHEREAS, Chapter 121 of the Fort Wayne Municipal Code of Ordinances was added to the Code in August 2019 by a simple majority vote of the Fort Wayne Common Council: and

WHEREAS, Chapter 121 defines a Sexually Oriented Business and other items related to such a business, outlines the requirement of licensure for certain businesses and employees, and prohibits certain conduct within these businesses; and

WHEREAS, the business in question are establishments, classified in Chapter 121 as "adult cabarets"; and

WHEREAS, since Chapter 121 was enacted, there has been no positive significant or noticeable change to the community, nor have any of the secondary effects noted in code significantly diminished; and

WHEREAS, the only significant change to the community has been the negative impact on the almost-exclusively female employees working in these establishments in terms of the opportunity to earn money and provide for themselves and their families; and

WHEREAS, the culture and behaviors that Chapter 121 was enacted to remove from the community have not been removed, but instead have moved into more clandestine operations, outside of certain protections provided by public establishments and into private homes, hotel rooms, and private parties, where the women are a greater risk without the benefit of security or societal expectations; and

WHEREAS, the clothing requirements in Chapter 121 are stricter than those of common, public society; and

WHEREAS, the licensing requirement has not been universally implemented, nor has it been effective and has led to confusion within the sexually oriented business community, as well as the licensing administrators;

WHEREAS, consenting adults should be permitted to undertake any activity that does not have a detrimental impact on themselves, other consenting adults, or the community; and

WHEREAS, the findings and rational in § 121.01 identifies the basis and legal justification for the ordinance and the definitions contained in § 121.02 are used elsewhere in the Fort Wayne Municipal Code of Ordinances; as a result, both sections should remain in full force and effect.

That under Fort Wayne Municipal Code Chapter 121: "SEXUALLY ORIENTED BUSINESSES," sections § 121.01 and § 121.02 shall remain in full force and effect.
