This ordinance is to authorize the payment of grants totaling \$104,999.96 for access programming by not-for-profit agencies, governmental groups and educational groups which do not originate access channels. This is the list of grantees and the amount received:

This money comes from the Cable Franchise fee remitted to the City of Fort Wayne. By local ordinance 111.34, ten percent of "access dollars" are designated for Non-Access Channel Originator Grants, subject to approval by City Council. Any funds not utilized for grants must remain in the fund for use the following year.

The budget for non-access originator grants is \$105,000, which is 10% of "access dollars" (4% of the total franchise fees) collected in the previous four quarters, plus grants not awarded in the previous year. In addition to funding cable channels and these grants, Cable Franchise fees provided \$1.36 million dollars to the City's general fund in the previous four quarters.
