Subject: Yearly Maintenance for general business telephone software

Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to authorize the purchase of yearly maintenance for CIC Telephone software maintenance from ConvergeOne for the operation of the City's telephone system. This year's cost of maintenance for telephone software is \$149,513.

Allen County also makes a payment in the same amount for their share of telephone software maintenance to ConvergeOne each year.

In exchange for maintenance fees, the software vendors provide support for problems with the software and periodically provide new versions of the software.

Our decision to pay maintenance rests on four tests:

- Do we have a continuing internal commitment to use this software?
- Is the software vendor continuing to improve the product?
- Is the vendor useful in solving problems with the software?
- If the software fails, what's the worst case scenario?

The City and County both have substantial investments in the use of this software. We receive regular updates to the software and support for our day to day operation of the software.

Based on these factors, I recommend continued funding of telephone software maintenance.
