WHEREAS, of these 58,220 service people, 8 were women, 1,534 were from Indiana; and

WHEREAS, there was reported over 2,500 service people unaccounted for as Missing in Action or as Prisoners of War, and

WHEREAS, Fort Wayne, Allen County, and the Northeast Indiana region hosts several hundred Vietnam veterans and their families living in this portion of our state, and

WHEREAS, a replica of the Vietnam Wall Memorial, located in Washington D.C., will be erected permanently at the Veterans National Memorial Shrine and Museum at 2122 O'Day Road, Fort Wayne, and

WHEREAS, this replica of the Vietnam Wall will be constructed at 80% scale of the original wall and stands 8 feet tall and 360 feet long, and

WHEREAS, the Vietnam Wall Memorial will be another outstanding addition to the Veterans National Memorial Shrine and Museum in Fort Wayne and bring thousands of visitors to this sacred area in our community, and

WHEREAS, the veteran community is beginning a fundraising drive to make improvements to the grounds of the shrine to accommodate the placement of the replica wall and eventually other monuments and tributes to honor all veterans of all wars.
