AN ORDINANCE approving the initial purchase and yearly maintenance for Next Generation 9-1-1 Command Center software at a total cost of \$2,095,207 from and through Motorola Solutions, Inc. by the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana,

WHEREAS, Allen County and the City of Fort Wayne jointly operate a 9-1-1 public safety communications center for the benefit of the local community;

WHEREAS, Allen County and the City of Fort Wayne have jointly agreed to share equally in the cost of upgrading and maintaining the 9-1-1 Command Center hardware and software;

WHEREAS, this contract addresses and includes all the hardware, software, legacy interfaces, connections, associated project management, installation, IP migration and transition, user training and other services needed to transition 9-1-1 services to the next generation of hardware and software;

WHEREAS, the public safety communications center is integral to the operation of police, fire, and 9-1-1 services:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the initial purchase of Next Generation 9-1-1 Command Center software and hardware from Motorola Solutions, Inc. for a cost to the City of \$507,013 is hereby approved in all respects. That said purchase will be used to ensure the proper operation of the City's police, fire and 9-1-1 systems.

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SECTION 2. That the yearly maintenance of Next Generation 9-1-1 Command Center software from Motorola Solutions, Inc. for the years 2021 through 2029 inclusive at a total of cost to the City of \$1,588,194 is hereby approved in all respects. That said yearly maintenance will be used to ensure the proper operation of the City's police, fire and 9-1-1 systems.

SECTION 3. That the City is authorized and directed to take all action necessary for the purchase of this system by and through Motorola Solutions, Inc.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.

Subject: Next Generation 9-1-1 Command Center

Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to authorize the purchase of Next Generation 9-1-1 Command Center from Motorola Solutions, Inc. for the operation of the City's police, fire and 9-1-1 departments. This is a shared purchase with Allen County. This total cost of the system is \$1,014,025. The City pays 50%, \$507,013. The annual maintenance cost is \$220,582 each year for 2021 through 2029, a total of \$1,985,238. Per the CCP interlocal agreement, the City pays 80% of the maintenance cost, a total of \$1,588,194.

This system covers call handling, call recording, wireless call locating, status monitoring, remote virtual operator provisioning, integration with SMS texts to 9-1-1, integration with the existing Police and Fire CAD system, and integration with the existing Police and Fire radio system.

The City and County both have substantial investments in the use of Spillman software. The Next Generation 9-1-1 Command Center is integrated into the Spillman system and our radio system. Fort Wayne Police Department has made significant investments in Standalone Video systems Genetec VMS, Avigilon ACC and Milestone XProtect (Camera Projects) that will require an updated platform for CCP to be able to integrate. This integration enhances the value of all three system components.

Next Generation 9-1-1 (NG9-1-1) encompasses enhanced location technology (Google), Text to 9-1-1, Text/Video to 9-1-1 all of which can be integrated into Next Generation Command Center.

This upgrade is critical to daily work of police, fire, and 9-1-1 dispatchers. Based on these factors, I strongly recommend the purchase of Next Generation 9-1-1 Command Center from Motorola Solutions, Inc.
