Subject: Yearly Maintenance for Accela software

Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to authorize the purchase of yearly maintenance for Land Management software from Accela, Inc for the operation of the City's permitting systems. This year's cost of maintenance for the software is \$114,447.

In exchange for maintenance fees software vendors provide support for problems and periodically provide new versions of software.

Accela is shared with Allen County and they will pay \$143,191 for Accela maintenance. Allen County pays more because they use additional software modules.

Our decision to pay maintenance rests on four factors:

- Do we have a continuing internal commitment to use this software?
- Does the software vendor modify the product to meet current needs?
- Does the vendor help solve problems with the software?
- If we don't use this software, are our alternatives?

In 2020 the City and County have contracted with outside vendors to install the latest version of Accela. This has improved the performance of the system.

Since we still have an internal commitment to use the software, and since we anticipate subsequent versions of the software will solve some of our existing problems, I recommend continued funding of Accela maintenance.
