8	counsel in multidistrict litigation; and

12	opioids' settlements under Indiana Code 4-6-16-2.
13	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of The
14	City of Fort Wayne, Indiana:
15	SECTION 1. The City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, having considered whether to
16	elect to opt back in to the opioids settlements under Indiana Code 4-6-15-2, hereby
17	resolves that The City of Fort Wayne now exercises its election to opt back in to the
	opioid settlements, and orders its duly authorized agent to submit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Indiana Attorney General by July 15, 2022. This Resolution
18	supercedes R-21-06-01.
19	SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and
20	after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Mayor.
