SYNOPSIS OF ORDINANCE. Approves a contract for construction of Riverfront Public Open Space Phase IIA between Hamilton Hunter Builders, Inc. and the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana in connection with the Board of Public Works. The contract amount is \$2,392,518.00.

EFFECT OF PASSAGE. Hamilton Hunter Builders, Inc. will be responsible for constructing Riverfront Public Open Space Phase IIA which is the park space along the south side of the St. Marys riverfront located between Promenade and Headwaters Parks. The proposed improvements include bank stabilization, new walkways, plantings, lighting, site furnishings, seatwalls, and utility improvements along with replacement of an existing retaining wall. Construction will start in May, 2022 and will be completed by November 30, 2022.

EFFECT OF NON-PASSAGE. Without approval of this contract, construction of this project will not move forward. The site is currently a construction staging area for the private development located on the south side of the project site and the majority of the site is covered in stone. The City has committed to completing this project by the end of 2022 to coincide with the completion of the private development. Without approval of this contract, the commitment will not be met.

MONEY INVOLVED (DIRECT COSTS, EXPENDITURES, SAVINGS). \$2,392,518.00 will come from Local Income Tax: Riverfront. The Local Income Tax increase approved by Council in 2017 and subsequent budgets have contemplated expenditures for engineering, design and planning work necessary for phases 2 and 3 of riverfront development.

The Community Development Division hereby requests that the Common Council consider and approve a construction contract for Riverfront Public Open Space Phase IIA between Hamilton Hunter Builders, Inc. and the City of Fort Wayne. The contract amount is \$2,392,518.00.

This project will create park space along the south side of the St. Marys riverfront located between Promenade and Headwaters Parks. The proposed improvements include bank stabilization, new walkways, plantings, lighting, site furnishings, seatwalls, and utility improvements along with replacement of an existing retaining wall. Construction will start in May, 2022 and will be completed by November 30, 2022.

Requests for bids for this project were publicly advertised (Resolution/Work Order #109-3-22-22-1). There were three plan holders; one of those companies submitted a bid. Staff has reviewed the bid and determined that it is responsive. The bid tabulation is attached.
