3 GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. G-_____

4 AN ORDINANCE amending the Thoroughfare
5 Plan of the City Comprehensive ("Master")
6 Plan by vacating public right-of-way.

7 WHEREAS, a petition to vacate public right-of-way within the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana,
8 (as more specifically described below) was duly filed with the City Clerk of the City of Fort Wayne,
9 Indiana; and

10 WHEREAS, Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana, duly held a public hearing
11 and approved said petition, as provided in I.C. 36-7-3-12.

12 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
13 FORT WAYNE, INDIANA:

14 SECTION 1. That the petition filed herein to vacate a public right-of-way within the City of
15 Fort Wayne, Indiana, more specifically described as follows, to-wit:

16 The north-south alley located west of Lot 383 in Hanna's Addition East Part to the City of Fort
17 Wayne recorded in Deed Book C, Page 526, in the Office of the Recorder of Allen County, more
18 particularly described as follows:

19 Beginning at the northwest corner of said Lot 383 thence southerly along the west line of said Lot
20 383, a distance of 150 feet to the southwest corner of said Lot 383; thence westerly along the
21 north right-of-way line of East Berry Street a distance of 10 feet to the southeast corner of Lot 3
22 in Skidders Subdivision recorded in Deed Book 52, Page 379, in the Office of the Recorder of
23 Allen County, Indiana; thence northerly a distance of 150 feet to a point on the east line of Lot 4
24 in said Skidders Subdivision; thence easterly a distance of 10 feet to the point of beginning.

25 and which vacating amends the Thoroughfare Plan of the City Comprehensive ("Master") Plan
26 and is hereby approved in all respects.

27 SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, any
28 and all necessary approval by the Mayor.

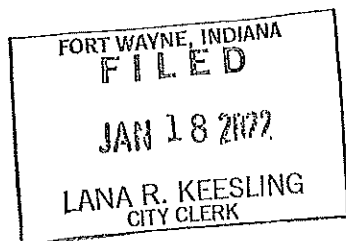
