13 FOR CITY VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT between the City of Fort Wayne, by and
14 through its Department of Purchasing and BOB THOMAS FORD for the FLEET
15 OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT, respectfully for:

16 Sublet body repairs for City vehicles and equipment involved in
17 accidents;

18 involving a total cost of ONE HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND AND 00/100
19 DOLLARS - (\$190,000.00) all as more particularly set forth in said FRAME
20 SERVICE ALIGNMENT AND BODY REPAIR FOR CITY VEHICLES AND
21 EQUIPMENT which is on file in the Office of the Department of Purchasing, and is
22 by reference incorporated herein, made a part hereof, and is hereby in all things
23 ratified, confirmed and approved.

Re: Bob Thomas Ford, Body repairs

Bob Thomas does a lot of the City body repairs from accidents throughout the year. The units are bid out weekly.

How ding day works for the City is those units that were involved in an accident the previous week are to be brought in every Tuesday morning by 9:00 am, then the following process;

- Body shops throughout the city and area come in and give quotes on the units to repair.
- The body shop then sends/emails the quotes to the service writer. Quotes have to be back in by Thursday morning.
- All quotes for each unit are put to a PDF file then sent to the Fleet Director for approval
- Fleet director looks over and awards to the lowest most responsive quote
- Departments are then notified to bring back in for repair.
