Whereas, the U.S. Congress enacted the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 ("ARPA") on March 11, 2021; and,

Whereas, ARPA provides emergency funding to state and local governments to support their recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic; and,

Whereas, the City of Fort Wayne has been allocated \$50,815,327.00 from the Coronavirus State and Local Fisçal Recovery Funds (under "ARPA") which must be obligated by the end of 2024 and expended by the end of 2026; and,

Whereas, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana adopted Special Ordinance S-58-21 on May 11, 2021 which established the purpose, permitted uses and minimum percentages per category of the ARPA fund; and,

Whereas, the Common Council of the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana adopted Resolution R-22-03-22 on April 12, 2022 approving the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana Recovery Plan, State & Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; and,

Whereas, City leaders have been deliberate and thoughtful on this process in order to adhere to federal rules and eligibility criteria while providing both an opportunity for community input and an opportunity to meet the most urgent and significant needs in Fort Wayne using areas of focus; and,

Whereas, the City of Fort Wayne desires to support organizations working to serve the community in the tourism, public health, small business, and non-profit sectors by implementing four separate subgrant programs utilizing ARPA funds subject to local, state, and federal regulations; and,

Whereas, the City of Fort Wayne is working diligently, using federal and state guidance and industry best practices, to ensure applicable programmatic, financial, and administrative eligibility and compliance for subgrant recipients; and,

Whereas, the City of Fort Wayne is also working to ensure the subgrants are targeted

1	towards industries, organizations, and community members most seriously impacted or		
2	disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic; and,
