Members of City Council:

This ordinance is to authorize the purchase of software services needed for proactive data management at a cost of \$170,134 from Trace3, LLC. The total price is \$283,556 and will be shared with Allen County.

This service purchased in partnership with Allen County, Fort Wayne Civil City, and City Utilities. This is a three-year agreement, and the cost will remain the same throughout the term.

This software helps meet the security needs of the City, County and the Utility in the following ways:

- Provides a foundation for a data management program. It will make us aware of sensitive data in Windows, Microsoft 365, and Active Directory that may be shared in inappropriate ways.
- The software alerts us to geo-hopping, identifying suspicious logins from foreign countries.
- When security incidents happen, the software assists in building a timeline of the incident and activity of the threat actor.
- It expands our current capabilities by providing access to a proactive incident response team. The Varonis team will alert us to threats in real time.
